### AGES:

#### **Preschool Program:**

Families can choose from 2 Days (T/Th), 3 Days (MWF) or 5 Days (M-F)

Children must be at least two years and six months old by September (must turn 3 by 3/31/21) to

Start school in September. An alternative January start date is available for children who miss

Our September cutoff (see Director for more information)

#### **Pre-Kindergarten Program (5 Days/week only, M-F):**

Must be at least four years and two months by Sept (must turn 5 by 7/31/21 and 4 by 7/31/20)

Maximum of five years and two months by Sept (must turn 6 after 7/31/21 and 5 after 7/31/20)

Note: Pre-k admission is based on age. Older children have priority.

HOURS: 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. -- Children bring their own lunches

REGISTRATION FEE: \$160 for one child & \$60 for each additional child in a family  
per year. This is a nonrefundable admission processing fee.  
Registration fee plus first month's tuition is collected now.

ENRICHMENT & EQUIPMENT FEE:

	Annual fee per child, collected in September
	\$150 – 2 day program
	\$200 – 3 day program
	\$250 – 5 Day and Pre-K program

WAIT LIST FEE: \$100 per family for new families

FEES: Pre-Kindergarten (five days)....\$11,750/year in 10 monthly payments of \$1,175  
5 days per week.....\$11,500/year in 10 monthly payments of \$1,150  
3 days per week .....\$7,250/year in 10 monthly payments of \$725  
2 days per week .....\$5,250/year in 10 monthly payments of \$525

### EXTENDED CHILD CARE:

Daily - 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. (\$10.00)  
1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. (\$20.00) Two hour blocks only  
3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. (\$20.00) Two hour blocks only

Your admission forms and information will be forwarded in May. We strongly recommend that you make an appointment for a physical exam for your child as soon as you receive your admission materials. A YEARLY physical is required by law and no student may enter the school without a physician signed health form.
