Consumer collective actions (LC-SC3-EC-1) – CSA (7.5M)

- Consumers now have the opportunity to actively engage in the energy market
- A precondition for active demand is for consumers to be aware of their own potential to permanently or temporarily reduce energy consumption and what is the monetary value of that potential in the market
- Different forms of collective action have the potential to assist consumers in forming critical mass and to facilitate increased uptake of energy efficiency and active demand solutions and services

Consumer collective actions (LC-SC3-EC-1) – CSA (7.5M)

ALL PROPOSED ACTIONS HAVE TO

Identify and address regulatory barriers and contractual conditions for cooperative actions

Demonstrate that collectively organised energy-related actions are financially viable and attractive to the members of the energy communities

SET UP AND SUPPORT ENERGY COMMUNITIES TO

Increase energy efficiency

Optimise energy management to integrate a greater share of renewable energy

COULD COVER

Identify and implement solutions to address split incentives

Demonstrate collective actions of energy consumers based on the solutions and business approaches using digital tools and technologies

Mitigating household energy poverty (LC-SC3-EC-2) – CSA (7.5M)

ALL PROPOSED ACTIONS HAVE TO

Contribute to actively alleviating energy poverty

Build on existing initiatives

Improve understanding of types and needs of energy poor households and ways to identify them

POSSIBLE PATHS (ONE OR MORE)

Behaviour change and low-cost measures

Support the set-up of financial and non-financial support schemes

Innovative schemes for energy efficiency/RE investments established by Obligated Parties under Article 7 EED

EU funding for sustainable energy investment after 2021-2027

- Horizon Europe (100bn)
 - €15 bn to Climate, Energy, Mobility
 - *Climate science and solutions; Energy supply; Energy systems and grids; Buildings and industrial facilities in energy transition; Communities and cities; Industrial competitiveness in transport; Clean transport and mobility; Smart mobility; Energy storage.*
- LIFE (5.45bn)
 - €1 bn to Clean Energy Transition
 - *Bridges the gap between the development of new knowledge and its implementation (some CSA project could be covered under LIFE)*

In particular, experts assist in:

- **Evaluation** of proposals, prize applications and tenders
- **Monitoring** of actions, grant agreements, public procurement contracts

In addition, experts provide opinion and advise on:

- **Preparation, implementation and evaluation of EU programmes and design of policies.**

In order to select experts, the European Union Institutions publish regularly calls for expression of interest (see list below) detailing the selection criteria, the required expertise, the description of the tasks, their duration and the conditions of remuneration.
