February Curriculum: Animals

Our animal theme will be continuing throughout the month of February. We enjoyed learning about the first two types of animals: domestic animals and animals that are native to the state of California. Thank you to the families that brought in their dog; the children enjoyed learning all about them, including what they eat, where they sleep, how old they are, etc. As we continue with this theme, we will be focusing our attention on the following animals:

- World Animals: The weeks of February 5th & February 12th
- Ocean Animals: The weeks of February 26th & March 5th
- Reptiles: The week of March 12th
- Birds: The week of March 19th
- Bugs: The Week of March 26th

Children have a natural curiosity for animals. Taking walks near the bay allows the children to observe the different animals that live near our school. Reading books allows the children to ask questions about what they are hearing (why do they live there? What kind of food do they eat? How can they survive in the cold, in the water, in the desert? Etc.) Art allows the children to create projects based on what they are learning while working on those important fine motor skills.

<u>Valentine's Day:</u> We will be having a Valentine's Day Exchange on <u>Wednesday, February 14th for M/W/F and 5 Day children.</u> We will <u>NOT</u> be doing a Valentines exchange with the T/TH children. The Tuesday/Thursday children will have the opportunity to create fun art projects and have a special snack. If your M/W/F or 5 Day child would like to bring Valentines, please remember the following:

- Bring only enough Valentines for your child's group.
- Say who the Valentine is **from**, but please don't put who the Valentine is **for**. This will help save us time and confusion while we are passing them out.
- Please, <u>no candy</u>, we will be having a special snack that day.
