Phishing for Your RSVP: A citizen reported a scam involving a fake wedding invitation sent via Evite. The email, received from a friend, contained a link that could harvest the recipient's contacts and perform other malicious actions. The reporter's security system flagged it as suspicious, preventing them from being compromised. CyberWyoming Note: This scam has been around for a while.

According to NBC 5 news report, victims who clicked on fake Evites have had their accounts locked, passwords and security questions changed, and their accounts used to send out further phishing emails. Always verify invitations with the sender before clicking any links, even if they appear to come from a friend. Keep your accounts secure with strong passwords and be cautious of unexpected emails, as scammers can reuse old breaches to trick you.

Package Scam on Hold: A Laramie resident reported receiving a scam text pretending to be from USPS, sent from a +44 number. The message claimed that a package was on hold due to incomplete address details and urged the recipient to update their address within 24 hours using a suspicious link. The recipient recognized the scam, as family members had encountered similar fraudulent messages before. The linked website asks for credit card information to pay a fee, which is a common tactic. *CyberWyoming Note: Talk about the scams you see and ask your friends and family to share their stories as well. Because this resident had heard about similar scams, they didn't respond to the text.*

If abuse, neglect, abandonment, intimidation or financial exploitation of an older adult is occurring, report it to Adult Protective Services.

Basics of what DFS/APS can do:

- If an abuse/neglect case is reported and opened, an APS
 Caseworker will respond within 24-72 hours, depending on immediate danger or impending harm.
- APS is mandated by statute to notify law enforcement.
- An APS Caseworker will interview the vulnerable adult to determine the facts of the situation.
- APS works with the vulnerable adult regarding availability of community services he/she is agreeable to receive in order to ensure his/her safety.

Basics of what DFS/APS cannot do:

- APS cannot force anyone to accept help, adults have the right to refuse.
- APS cannot force anyone to reside in a nursing home, APS is committed to keeping vulnerable adults as safe as possible, in their own homes.
