YOUR MISSION

IDENTIFYING THE MAJOR COMPONENTS OF YOUR MISSION:

WHAT:

What is it that you do? How do you help people? What skills do you bring to the table?

WHO:

Who do you want to serve, work with and be around?

WHEN:

When do you want to be working? Are you working during the day and playing during the night? Are you playing during the day and working at night? Think about the schedule that you want. This will determine the type of jobs and the timezone.

YOUR MISSION

WHERE:

Where do you want to live? Where do you work? Where are the people and communities you'd like to serve/impact?

WHY:

Why are you doing what you're doing? Evaluate the reasoning behind all of your actions. What is it about the work you want to do - why is it calling you in this direction?

YOUR MISSION

ASK YOURSELF:

How can I contribute to the world?

What do I want to be remembered for?

If I had a year to live, what would I do?

What would I stop doing?

YOUR MISSION

Out of all of the answers above, what feels the most important to you?

Make a list of the 5 - 10 key points you want or need out of your future work/job. (location, the people, the skills you use, the impact you make, the timezone, etc.) Then number them 10 being least important, 1 the most.

YOUR MISSION

Create your mission statement out of these key points.

Use the words and phrases you have written down in the last section to create a sentence. You don't have to use them all and you can use other words too, but you will want to make sure the top 3 are in there somehow.

Try not to overthink this one!

Now, what would this job look like?

Can you imagine yourself living this mission?

Does this job already exist? Have you seen a job like it?

What position would you have based on your skills, experience and passion?

If it doesn't exist, can you create it?

YOUR MISSION
