Obd Auto Doctor – 911CarTools.com Along with your ability to modify your car's engine and exterior, there are several improvements that you can make to your vehicle's diagnostic system, and some can be rather handy if you find yourself ever in a bind. For example, your car may be having issues with your gas tank, or it may suddenly be losing power to all four wheels. If you find yourself stuck somewhere without a working map or cell phone, you will be in a tough position. Your best bet in such a scenario is to have a working diagnostic system. You can also get a basic scanner for your car at any electronics or auto part store. A scanner will be able to tell you when your battery is nearing the end of its life, or if you're simply low on gas. How Can I Get A Car Diagnostic Scanner? You can buy a car diagnostic scanner for around \$100 from many electronics or auto parts stores. It's very simple to use, as there are no specialized car-related training required to operate a scanner. It works like a regular car radio scanner, in that it can pick up FM radio signals and the scanner will translate that information into sound. What's more, it can detect the radio frequency of the vehicle diagnostic codes as well. There are also scanners that can be used in conjunction with the OBD-II connector, and these can be purchased at most auto parts stores for about \$15. There are also auto repair shops that can scan for you at a reasonable rate, but a diagnostic scanner can make the job easier. How Does A Scanner Work? The scanner uses a device called a wand to pick up the frequencies. You can get a wand for less than \$15 at any auto parts store. The wand works similar to an antenna, in that it can pick up the frequency of signals from the OBD-II connector. As for a handheld scanner, a more expensive one will be able to pick up signals in all four-quadrant corners of your car, but a wand only covers one quadrant at a time. All of this information is then fed into the scanner, which converts it into sound. You'll hear things like radio stations, but you can also hear the vehicle diagnostic codes at the top of the radio.
