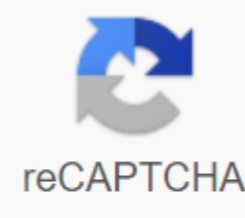

Hamilton is very good, but this book was a little more technical than his Handbook on Pentateuch. However, if I were to teach this class again, I would use the same book. Hamilton does not shy away from the problems between the text and other historical/archaeological evidence, but he provides many plausible solutions and leaves his own intellect to his readers to decide when difficult choices should be made. The Book of History Handbook provides a thorough study of Joshua, the judges, Ruth, Samuel, the Kings, Chronicles, Ezra Nehemia, and Esther. The text is a bit verbose in the sections and can be difficult to follow from time to time... the reason the book didn't get 5 stars from me.
