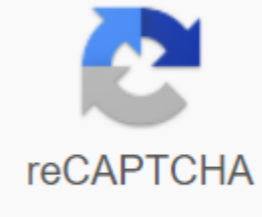

Once you open the workflow, play around! You can start by pressing the green start button at the top of the screen. Looks something like this: If you got this far, congratulations! Before Start, I wanted to lay out my professional experience as a primer and distinguish this guide from others that you can see in the Alteryx community and online. This guide is focused on those with rudimentary or no programming or technical background - we will start from scratch. My story - from organizational consulting to data and analytics Consulting! began my career in organizational consulting - to name a few areas of work this included competence modeling, strategic workforce planning, organizational structure design, leadership development, and reward strategy. My first introduction to the more technical side of these things was four years later, in the fall of 2018, when I decided to return to graduate school to turn into a career that was more data and analytics driven. I learned R as my first programming language in early 2019 for machine learning and social media applications. The learning curve was steep and I struggled the first month just trying to understand the logic and syntax. I've gotten to familiarity over time, but like any language you're not familiar with as a beginner, once you stop practicing it's hard to keep progress. I went through the same experience when I decided to try my hand at Alteryx. Attempt #1 - My first exam I never used Alteryx at work. The first time I started dragging and dropping tools to create a workflow, when I had to prepare for the Data and Analytics Academy's I had a week to familiarize myself with Alteryx and watched interactive lessons, taking notes and pausing to do questions at the end of each lesson. There was a lot of going back and forth. I also had Alteryx open on my laptop and experimented with the tool mentioned in each lesson. I've completed a few weekly tasks in the Alteryx community. I thought to myself: If I invest time in exploring this new platform, I should at least get certified. Since the Alteryx Designer Core exam, which tests the core tool, or widely used tools in Alteryx, is an open book and can be passed every seven days, I decided to try it out. It was the first technical exam I tried. I spent three hours studying for two weeks before the exam and tried it on a Thursday night in August 2019. I had a tempo desk in front of me to estimate how many questions I should finish in a certain amount of time, opened notes in Microsoft Word that I took during my research sessions, and countless tabs in my browser. I didn't make it. However, what was extremely helpful was the breakdown of scores, the detailed percentage (%) the questions answered correctly according to each category of tools (such as Cross Tab and Transpose, Entrance, etc.), which served as the key for which tools I had to focus on, while tagging the ones I understood understanding. Major resources and tips for passing Alteryx Designer Core Exam I tried Alteryx Designer Core certification again on January 11, 2020 and finally passed! It was a painful process that required a lot of self-motivation, as I studied for two hours from 9 to 11pm after work, and 6 hours on weekends, for two weeks in a row. Below are the resources that I used when I was studying for an exam and tips for exam day, which I believe were the key to passing above the minimum required (80%): Key Resources1. Alteryx Designer Essential Exam Preparation GuideRead is the first - it has all the information you need to know about the exam.2 Interactive lessons Alteryx3. Alteryx Community Weekly Calls To Fill All Beginner Problems, then Intermediate Problems If Time Allows.4 To quickly learn the tools and how to set them up, look for each tool in the top right corner of Alteryx (look for a magnifying glass icon) and click on the Open Example button. You'll then see inputs that simulate different outputs, describing how the tool affects in different situations.5 Alteryx No.6 documentation categories. Alteryx Community Tool Mastery Index No. 7. Alteryx Core Certification Practice Test8. With a quick Google search, you can find more practice Alteryx issues to try. Other resources9. Alteryx No10. Alteryx No.11 file types. Alteryx DateTime Formats No.12. The final input flow of the data13. Best Practices Alteryx14. Why Your Join Gets More Records Than Than Open these tabs in a separate window from the exam. Know the order and what information is on each tab to quickly switch between tabs and CTRL-F with the keyword from the question to quickly find the answer. While there is a list of tools to focus on in the Alteryx Designer's Essential Certification Exam Preparation Guide, I've noticed that questions about the following tools tend to appear more frequently in the exam: A. Inputb. Join and Unionc. Transpose and Cross TabSome questions from the Alteryx Designer Core Certification Exam Preparation Guide may also appear on the exam, since most, if not all, are taken from the bank issue. Exam Day Tips1. If you have two monitors, use two monitors - one with an open exam tab and the other with Alteryx and all tabs open, so you don't have to frantically switch back and forth during the exam.2 Scan all 80 questions and see which questions are practical application questions (7 out of 80, but worth 3 points each, or 26% of the entire exam) to know how to pace yourself throughout the exam. You will need at least 2-3 minutes for these questions. You can always go back to previous issues, so it's ok to do that. Just make sure you don't accidentally hit the Finish button now and finish the exam prematurely!3. Write down on a separate sheet of paper that you are unsure of and need to return to. Notice the practical issues of application.4 Keep the table pace - insert it on the side of your laptop and make sure you have at least 10 minutes after completing all 80 questions to get back and check which ones you were sure of. The practical application questions were the ones I struggled with as you would have to download the dataset (s) and build a workflow (s) in Alteryx to answer questions that might be one or choose anything to apply the question. Here's how I'd like to address these types of issues: a. Keep in mind the KISS method - Keep it simple stupid. Fewer tools can give the desired output.b. Keep a pen and a few sheets of paper handy as you have to spend 30-45 seconds figuring out how to approach the question to get the right answer (s). There may be several ways to get the same answer, so be sure to come up with at least two ways, if possible, on one to choose questions.c. For Choose everything that applies questions, use the elimination process to delete which workflow (s) will give the wrong conclusion. The rest are the ones that potentially have to work. Having actively used Microsoft Excel previously, I realized that I may have managed to find the answer to what was requested faster than in Alteryx. While this may work for some issues as the datasets are not encrypted, I have found that many sets I had to download were encrypted and limited data manipulation in Microsoft Excel. In short, try these questions in Alteryx Alteryx like no time to waste. Designer Core Certified BadgeArmed and Ready! hope this short guide makes venturing into Alteryx and preparing for the Alteryx Designer Core exam for a less challenging activity. Strive.
