

Often called our 'national cancer', Australia has the highest rate of **skin cancer** of the world. Two in three Australians will develop skin cancer in their lifetime, and every year around 2,000 Aussies will die from this disease. The good news is that skin cancer is largely preventable by minimising exposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation from the sun. Being SunSmart is a simple and effective way to reduce your risk of developing skin cancer. ### REMINDERS ON OPEN WATER SWIMMING

Factors to keep in mind - particularly as we enter the summer season, the elements can change very quickly at this time of the year.

- Outside Ambient Temp
- Water Temp
- Sun Protection
- Length of Time in the water
- Wind Factor
- Keep in mind Your Own Barometer
- If you get cold, alert your Buddy or Coach that swims near you, don't try and continue swimming because everyone else is. ALERT, ADVISE turn around go back
- Make a plan to swim a achievable distance, you can always repeat the distance with your buddy, Always Advise what the plan is.
- Double Cap you lose body heat very quickly through the top of your head
- Keep your swimming Safe and Achievable


