



# How to Transform Your Mountain of Faith

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### I. Anchor Faith in R\_\_\_\_\_

- 1. Make God's Word Your Final A\_\_\_\_\_.** Decide that what God says is more reliable than what you feel, what culture says, or what circumstances suggest.
- 2. Spend C\_\_\_\_\_ Time in the Word, Not Just Occasional Time.** Let Scripture shaping be part of your daily thinking and shape how you see everything, not just something you do in church or devotions.
- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit to Turn I\_\_\_\_\_ into Revelation.** Reading the Bible gives you knowledge, but knowledge is not revelation until the Holy Spirit brings illumination and personal application.
- 4. Obey What God R\_\_\_\_\_, Even in Small Things.** Live what God shows you no matter how small, and every act of obedience will deepen faith.
- 5. Guard Your Mind from C\_\_\_\_\_ Truth Sources.** Anchored faith requires discernment, so choose carefully which voices get authority in your life.
- 6. Reinforce Revelation Through Kingdom C\_\_\_\_\_.** Isolation often leads to confusion, but community strengthens clarity, so confirm and strengthen revelation through other faithful believers.
- 7. Meditate on Truth Until It Shapes How You Think.** Trade sporadic reading for deep meditation and reflection so truth can settle in your heart and become part of how you naturally think and respond.

### II. Move from Revelation to R\_\_\_\_\_

- 1. Slow Down Enough to L\_\_\_\_\_ to God.** Revelation often gets drowned out by noise—busy schedules, constant media, and nonstop mental activity so to be receptive to revelation, start creating space for God to speak.
- 2. Approach God's Word with E\_\_\_\_\_, Not Just Routine.** Do not read Scripture just for information or you will miss revelation. When you open the Word, expect God to speak personally.
- 3. Stay H\_\_\_\_\_ and T\_\_\_\_\_.** As water flows downhill, do, revelation flows easiest into a humble heart, so be willing to let God correct you, redirect you, or expand your understanding even when it challenges your current thinking.
- 4. Respond Q\_\_\_\_\_ When God Speaks.** Ignoring what God shows you often dulls spiritual sensitivity., so, when God shows you something, respond, and your spiritual sensitivity will sharpen and increase.
- 5. Stay C\_\_\_\_\_ to the Holy Spirit.** The Holy Spirit is the one who makes revelation personal and alive, so talk to the Holy Spirit, ask for understanding, and be open to His conviction, guidance, insight, and direction.
- 6. Stay in C\_\_\_\_\_ with Other Believers.** God often confirms revelation through other believers, so seek a mature community to help you test, refine, and confirm what you sense God is saying.
- 7. Filter Out Voices That C\_\_\_\_\_ with God's Voice.** Too many voices create confusion, so intentionally avoid influences that contradict God's truth and turn down competing voices so you can clearly hear God's voice.

### III. Make Sure Your Life Is A\_\_\_\_\_

**1. Let God's Truth Challenge You, Not Just C\_\_\_\_\_ You.** Stop approaching God's Word like a motivational book and start approaching it like a mirror.

**2. Start With R\_\_\_\_\_ Your Mind.** Before God changes your life, He changes how you see life, so let realignment start in your thinking, by shaping the way you choose, so that the way you choose may shape the way you live.

**3. Remove S\_\_\_\_\_ from the Throne.** The most difficult, yet the most freeing thing about realignment is that you don't have to be in charge.

**4. Replace "What Do I F\_\_\_\_\_?" With "What Did God S\_\_\_\_\_?"** Feelings are real, but they are not always reliable, so learn to respect emotions but submit them to truth.

**5. Let Obedience Become Your D\_\_\_\_\_ Response.** The alignment of your faith can only be visible through your obedience because obedience is where faith stops being theory and becomes transformation (James 1:22).

**6. Expect Alignment to Touch Every Area of L\_\_\_\_\_.** Real faith doesn't stay in one corner of your life; it affects your priorities, your relationships, your finances, your decisions, and your future, so let faith be the organizing center of everything else in your life.

**7. Alignment Is O\_\_\_\_\_, Not One-Time.** Alignment isn't a one-time moment; it's a lifelong process; as you grow, God's Word will keep adjusting and refining your heart, your thinking, and your priorities. (Colossians 2:6).

#### **IV. Let Faith G\_\_\_\_\_ Your Life**

**1. Move From Occasional Faith to Daily D\_\_\_\_\_ on God.** Stop letting faith be your emergency plan - something you turn to only in crisis or church and let it become operating system in every moment. (Romans 1:17).

**2. Let God's Word Become Your Decision-Making S\_\_\_\_\_.** Let God's Word become the lens through which you evaluate choices, relationships, priorities, and opportunities. (John 17:17).

**3. Align Your T\_\_\_\_\_, Not Just Your Behavior.** Faith truly governs when it reshapes how you think, not just what you do. (Romans 12:2).

**4. Practice Immediate and Consistent O\_\_\_\_\_.** Let obedience become instinct - your first response, not your last resort.

**5. Remove Competing L\_\_\_\_\_ from Your Life.** Faith must fully govern and it cannot rule if something else is sitting on the throne, so, intentionally surrender fear, money, approval, comfort, control etc. and transformation will happen automatically. (Matthew 6:24).

**6. Allow Faith to Shape Every Area, Not Just S\_\_\_\_\_ Areas.** Kingdom faith is not compartmentalized; it is integrated and must govern every area of your life - your family decisions, work ethic, relationships, finances, leadership, etc. (1 Corinthians 10:31).

**7. Stay Surrendered as a L\_\_\_\_\_, Not a One-Time Moment.** Faith governing your life is not a one-time surrender; it is a way of life with each season requiring new levels of trust and obedience. Luke 9:23).

#### **V. Transform Faith by Living It P\_\_\_\_\_**

**1. Stop Separating Faith From D\_\_\_\_\_ Life.** Faith transforms when it moves from being a religion to something that shapes how you live every day everywhere.

2. **Let Your Character Reflect Your B\_\_\_\_\_.** Public faith is first seen through character before it is heard through words, so let integrity, honesty, humility, patience, and love communicate be the reality of your faith daily. (1 Peter 2:12).
3. **Speak Truth with W\_\_\_\_\_ and Grace.** Living faith publicly does not mean being loud or confrontational—it means being clear, loving, and confident in truth. (Colossians 4:6).
4. **Represent Christ in Your W\_\_\_\_\_ and Responsibilities.** Faith becomes public when people can see excellence, integrity, and purpose in how you work and leadership. (Colossians 3:23).
5. **Show Compassion and S\_\_\_\_\_ Others.** Public faith is powerful when it is expressed through service. You don't have to be preachy all the time; when people experience kindness, generosity, and care from you, they experience the reality of your faith.
6. **Stand Firm in Truth Without F\_\_\_\_\_ of Culture.** Stand for truth when it is unpopular. Live confidently under God's authority rather than cultural pressure. (Acts 5:29).
7. **See Yourself as a K\_\_\_\_\_ Representative Everywhere You Go.** Stop seeing yourself as just a believer who goes to church and start seeing yourself as an ambassador of Christ with authority to represent the King in every space you enter on earth.
