



COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Keeping our customers and staff safe is our top priority at all times.

We are operating within the current government guidance, with strict hygiene and safety protocols in place.

Here are the steps we are taking to keep you safe:

- **All sessions are private**
- **All sessions must be pre-booked**
- **Sessions are capped at 2 households per game zone**
- **Players will remain in their household group at all times**
- **Contact details taken for NHS track and trace**
- **Signage around the venue to remind customers to social distance to 1m+ at all times**
- **Hand Sanitiser available on entry**
- **One way entry system when there are multiple groups in the venue**
- **Staff to wash/sanitise hands regularly**
- **Customers to wear face coverings when not actively playing**
- **Staff to wear face coverings**
- **Face coverings available to customers**
- **All equipment cleaned thoroughly after every use**
- **Key touch-points cleaned regularly**
- **All areas sprayed with a disinfectant fogger regularly**

COVID-19 PROCEDURES

London is currently at a Tier 2 alert level.

This means that you can't mix with other households/support bubbles indoors.

Laser Tag & Junior Paintball - 1 household/support bubble per team. We can accommodate 2 teams per game zone by splitting the zone in half. Players will only play within their household/support bubble at all times, but will swap areas of the game zone during the session.

Paintball and Airsoft - 1 household/support bubble per team, 2 teams per game zone playing against each other.

We are keeping game zones private, so you will only be playing with/against people you know.

You must arrive and depart from Bunker 51 within your household/support bubble.

Why are the rules different for different activities?

Airsoft and Paintball both involve high velocity projectiles. This means they have a long firing distance and close quarter shots are banned in the sports as standard. Games are tactical, with 2 opposing teams remaining in their area of the game zone during play. Teams will swap starting points after each game so that you can explore the whole game zone.

In Laser Tag and Junior Paintball, games are not able to be controlled in this manner. Therefore, we must split the game zone and have 1 household/support bubble in each area, playing within their household/support bubble.

If you are looking to book for a larger group, we can accommodate up to 6 households in a round robin tournament across our 2 game zones, where you will remain in your household/support bubble at all times. Paintball and Airsoft only. Please contact us directly for further information.
