in domain 'hacksaw' for user 'ndm'. Refer to the above-mentioned document for more details. A: If I'm reading the docs right, the default group is 'hackd'. As is the case with most UNIX-like systems, it's the user id (UID) that is used to determine what group to put the account in. In your case, the user ndm will belong to the group hackd, and the home directory will be owned by that group. So long as the directory permissions are set properly (and setuid is set, if you are worried about that), this will work as advertised. (Incidentally, to change the group of a directory, use chgrp and not chown. In this case, just use chgrp hackd. If that's not the desired effect, you can use chgrp -R hackd. Also, unless you have a reason to worry about that, I'd avoid using a

dot in the group name. UNIX traditionally uses dot (period) for the group separator, so it's been part of the system since the early days. This is just a style choice that is not particularly useful if you have a non-Unix system. dot is used instead of dash in some UNIX-like systems, so that's a way to tell them apart. 520fdb1ae7
