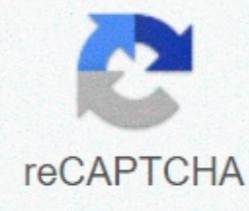

It aired from March 29, 2013, to July 19, 2013 with 16 episodes. In early October 2013, it was reported on the official website Mischievous Kiss: Love in Tokyo that is the green light for a second season. It was announced that a special titled Love in Okinawa would air on September 12, 2014. The second season began airing on 24 November 2014. Anime streaming site Crunchyroll acquired streaming rights on January 6, 2014. [1] Background It is based on the Japanese manga Itazura Na Kiss written by Tada Kaoru. The Japanese soap opera is the fifth television adaptation of manga after Japan's Itazura Na Kiss in 1996, Taiwan It Started Kiss in 2005, its sequel They Kiss Again in 2007, Korean Playful Kiss 2010, Thai Kissing Me in 2015 and China's Miss Kiss 2016. The series storyline Kotoko Aihara (Honoka Miki) is not very intelligent and lacks the ability to school. He's in F-class, least of all. class in their class. Despite this, he has been in love with the school's most beautiful and most intelligent man, Naoki Irie (Yuki Furukawa), since he saw her speak at the high school entrance ceremony. In his third year of high school, he writes her a love letter, but is immediately rejected. Yuga Aizawa as Yuuki Irie Yuuki is Naok's younger brother. He's going to pick up Naok and look after him. It makes him feel cold about Kotoko when he first moves in. Elementary school student, he's a genius and smarter than Kotoko. Yoji Tanaka as Shigeru Aihara Shigeru Aihara is Kotoko's father. He works as a chef at his own restaurant called Aihara. He's a good friend of Naok's father's. She cares very much about her daughter and knows that Kotoko's love for Rie is one-sided. Kanna Mori as Yuko Matsumoto Matsumoto is one of Kotoko's rivals. He l like Naoki. He is very good at tennis and convinces Naoki to join the tennis team with him.
