hike: to walk through the countryside, mountain, or forest area (verb)



The boys really enjoy taking a long **hike** up the mountain.

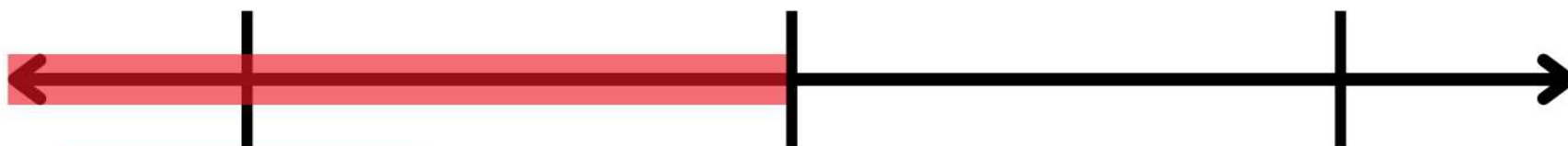


Simple Past Tense Verbs

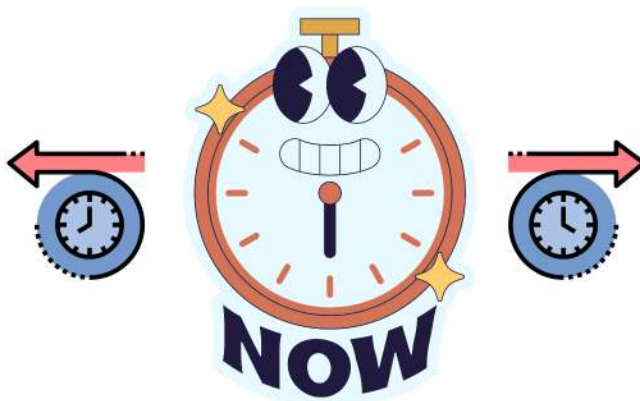
We use **past** simple for things that have already happened.

next year

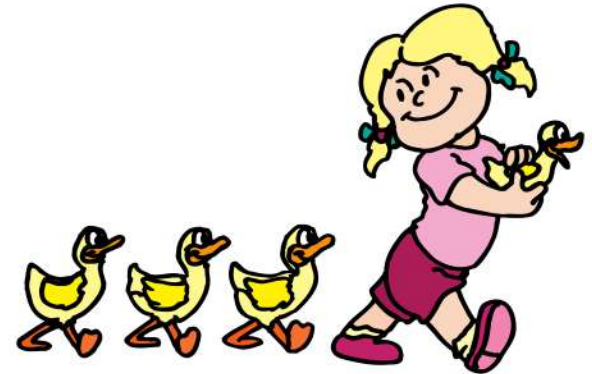
Simple Past Tense Verbs

Verb ends in a vowel sound or a voiced consonant (l, n, r, b, g, m, z, s, v), then the **-ed** ending sounds like a /d/

called**ed**
cleaned**ed**
offered**ed**
enjoyed**ed**
used**ed**
followed**ed**



loved**ed**
