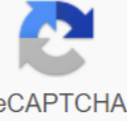

Useful links: Click here for current affairs June 11, 2019 INDIAN AFFAIRS Clean drinking water for all by 2024: Center June 11, 2019, Minister Jal Shakti, Gajendra Singh Shekhawat announced that the central government has pledged to provide clean drinking water to all citizens by 2024, which is one of the poll promises given by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Key points: i. The ministry assured that the plan will benefit more than 14 households. ii. Current status: currently only 19 per cent of rural households have access to drinking water. iii. Drinking water coverage: It is less than 5 percent in the states of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha, while Sikkim has 99 percent. iv. The Ministry of Jal Shakti recently launched the Nal se Jal scheme, which aims to provide drinking water by 2024. v. Background: During the 17th Election Campaign in Lok Sabha, Prime Minister Narendra Modi promised to establish a comprehensive ministry to address water issues. IRSDC has signed a tripartite agreement with SNCF and the Indian Railway Station Development Corporation AFD (IRSDC), entered into a tripartite agreement with the French National Railways (SNCF) and the French Development Agency (AFD). Under the agreement, a grant of up to 7 lakh euros will be provided to increase the capacity for the railway station development program in India. Key points: i. Key points: i. In the event with the participation of the heads of more than 30 Indian companies, ii. Preliminary agreements were given during meetings of B2B (business business), also known as the electronic business. The Forum was provided with detailed information on business opportunities in Kazakhstan, conditions, government support and the competitive advantages of attracting foreign investment. The index was released on May 28, 2019 by Save the Children (UK), a non-profit organization that works for children's rights. In 2019, India ranked 116th out of 172 countries. The index was topped by Singapore with a score of 989 points, and 8 European countries are in the top 10. In the 10th position was South Korea. This decline is greater than the RBI (Reserve Bank of India) estimate. This shows a positive sign of recovery from non-performance of the load of assets, as the ratio of NPA to both public and private banks showed a semi-annual decline, for the first time since March 2015, the decline is supported by a review of the quality of RBI assets, as well as the adoption of a bankruptcy law to resolve cases. For the first time Alibaba (7th) overtook Tencent (8th place) to become the most valuable Chinese brand. APPOINTMENTS and RESIGNS Sharda Kumar named interim CVC June 11, 2019, Prime Minister Narendra Modi led a selection team named vigilance commissioner Sharda Kumar as interim Central Commissioner of Vigilance (CVC) for a period of four years they are 65 years old. The move comes after central vigilance commissioner (CVC) KV Choudary completed his stay in Body. Key points: Mr. Sharda Kumar was the former head of the National Investigative Agency (NIA). ii. He was appointed Vigilance Commissioner in June 2018 and his term of office will end in October 2020. About central vigilance commission Headquarters: New Delhi as it is the pinnacle of vigilance institution. It was established on the basis of an executive resolution (based on the recommendations of the Santanam Committee) in 1964, but was awarded statutory status in 2003. He is presenting his report to the President of India. This body is now composed of a central vigilance commissioner along with two vigilance commissioners. Their term of office is 4 years or 65 years. The Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO) conducted tests from the island of Dr. Abdul Kalam in the Bay of Bengal. HSTDV will help DRDO develop technology for futuristic missions. With this launch, India joined the United States, Russia and China, which possess this technology. Key points: i. HSTDV, developed by DRDO with the help of Israel and the United Kingdom, will be mounted on a solid rocket engine to reach the required height. Once the required height is reached, the cruise ship will be thrown out of the launch vehicle. This is a dual-use technology project with civilian applications. iii.
