We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. The process was changed on how we received our sample schedules, and the radiological sample was not listed on our sample schedule on the new process. We took our samples as soon as we received notice they were late. We are now back in compliance with our sampling.
