The Clinical Adventurer is an international placement experience designed to engage and immerse undergraduate paramedic students in clinically relevant activities while they experience the people, food and culture of their host nation.

You will travel to islands, jungles and mountain villages to work alongside local clinicians in hospitals, remote clinics, and local ambulances. It is an opportunity for you to experience how health care is delivered outside of Australia.

It's not all emergency care. You will be delivering preventative health care programs, primary care assessments and emergency response training.

You will also complete Australia's only Expedition Medicine Life Support program, accredited by the Academy of Extreme Environment Medicine.


Nepal


Timor Leste

Timor-Leste, also known as East Timor, is a southeast asian nation located less than an hour from Darwin. Gaining independence in 2002, it is one of the world's youngest countries. Timor-Leste boasts stunning landscapes, from rugged mountains to pristine beaches and coral reefs. The country has a rich cultural heritage influenced by Austronesian traditions and Portuguese colonial history.


Vanuatu

An island nation in the South Pacific, consists of around 80 volcanic islands stretching over 1,300 kilometers. The capital, Port Vila, is the cultural and economic hub. Vanuatu has a rich indigenous culture, with over 100 languages spoken and unique traditions still practiced. The nation is famous for its active volcanoes, world-class diving sites, and warm hospitality.

Admin & Logistics

Our team will take care of all the planning, logistics and admining including airport transfers, in-country transport, accommodation, food, permits and permissions.

Risk Strategy

Our team will provide a generic, country specific and village risk mitigation strategy that will work to protect the team. As part of this process an expedition handbook will be distributed to all team members.

Operational Support (24/7)

Your team will be allocated a team specific operations manager who will be in regular contact with the team leaders throughout the program providing 24/7 support.

Team leaders

Each team is allocated a clinically qualified and experienced team leader who will be with the team from their arrival to departure.

In Country Agent and in country staff

A designated in country agent (ICA) will meet the team at the airport and facilitate an in-country orientation. They will support the team leader in all administrative and logistical requirements. Our in country support staff are experts in their chosen fields and will support the team through clinical support, translation, cooking, transport and security.
