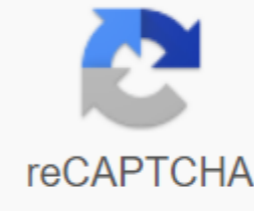




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## 2000 buick century repair manual

Old Candle Ignition Images Rog999 from Fotolia.com Replacing The Ignition Candles in the 1999 Buick Century can be challenging because, while the front three are easy to get to, the rear three ignition candles are not easy to access and you may need to use stepladder to achieve them. Replacing ignition candles can help increase fuel economy and engine performance. Open the hood to access the engine compartment. Find the sparkplug wires in front of the engine. The wires can be traced from the coil pack installed behind the engine. Follow the bright orange wire in front of the engine that is connected to the engine cylinder. Pull the sparkplug wire, gently twisting and pulling it. This will expose the sparkplug. Unscrew the sparkplug by placing a 5/8 deep socket well attached to the socket key over the sparkplug and unscrew it from the engine cylinder. Replace the new sparkplug. Insert the new sparkplug and screw it by hand. Tighten the sparkplug with a key socket to make sure it is tight. Tap the sparkplug wires at the end of the sparkplug and click. The wire will be locked in place. Repeat the steps to replace each ignition candle. You may have to stand on the step ladder to reach the back of three ignition candles. Always change sparkplugs one at a time to ensure sparkplug wires are connected to the right cylinder. Make sure the car is off and the keys are out of the ignition. Buick is often seen as a car line for somnolent retirees. Or it's not thinking about everyone these days. But the introduction to the New York Auto Show convertible four-seater is pictured here designed to demonstrate that GM is serious about creating new, exciting upscale Buicks in the next few years. And the production version of the Velite convertible will be one of them. The concept is also the output of the lot for the platform on which it is built, zeta, which was developed primarily by the Corporation's Australian division, Holden, for its new VE Commodore sedans. This rear-wheel-drive/all-wheel-drive architecture is expected to form the basis for various Buicks, Chevrolet and Pontiac's Future. Given that the zeta is a redesigned version of the Holden Holden platform underpins the current Pontiac GTO, we expect when Pontiac gets its version of the updated platform within three years it will be the basis for the next GTO. That future Chevy will be a little harder to pin. It could be two doors, says the source, or four doors, but it definitely won't be a camaro revival, says GM product honcho Bob Lutz. A long sculptural hood, complete with stylized portholes, slopes down to the modernist version of the Waterfall Grill Buick and opens forward, a cot style to reveal acres of plastic engine cover. The rear end is designed to evoke the old Y-Job, The first Buick concept car since 1938, and also carries a clear reminder of the boattail designs of the 30s- you know, where the rear opening deck completely hides a folding softtop. The show car has no roof, hidden or otherwise. If there was an upper, it would have a long passenger compartment to cover. The rear seat looked marketable, with a banquet design designed to create, in Buick's words, a jazz lounge atmosphere. The interior of the upcavenger is made of leather of at least three colors, called Bronze Pearl, Iceberg Blue, and Woven Tan. Instead of a wood finish, Velite has a gold leaf varnish adorning the interior in places that you would normally find wood. As usual, various high-tech gadgets are included. One is the E-lock, a system that blocks and unlocks the car using a key fob that ensures it is turned on without inserting the key. Another is the so-called X-Beam lighting system, which uses smaller lenses than reflective headlights, but are said to produce a 44 percent greater luminous intensity from the same halogen halogen As for Buick, let's hope his future looks so bright.
