Along with Aaron Dembsky-Bowden in Betrayer, fans have got The Chosen Horne and Hearn: An Eight-Time Way to Help Flesh out the Legion, and Eater Worlds easily slips to help fill in the gaps between these tales. After their escape from Terra, a legion of World Eaters collapses on themselves. Isolated amid the time of the distorted reality of the Eye of Terror, more and more of their numbers become victims of butcher's nails every day. Already several warbands are chipping away from them, with others threatening to leave, and the legion itself commanded bloodthirsty maniacs. For the few who still maintain their sanity, it is obvious that the XII is on the verge of breaking, and completely, and needs unity. The first thing to praise immediately is the length of the novel. What too often hamstrung certain tales is the ultra-short nature of many previous Black Library stories, and sticking to that size would have crippled the Eater worlds. Fortunately, the result is a foresight that fans get more of a short novel, two hundred and twenty-two pages long and fully flesh out the road leading to Skalthrax. The result is rather than a rushed tale focusing solely on a few main characters, something that readers are given a significant cast worthy of any Horus Heresy installment and more time to really focus on their ideas about immediate conflict. Novella makes it clear from the outset that the world of eaters are just inches away from the blood of the frenzied M41 warbands. While much still regrets the Chaos, many of them have begun to pray to the Father of Blood, and many others are losing themselves in the war. Limited aboard their ships, sudden, courageous outbreaks of violence are widespread among warriors. It is depicted with an atmosphere of quiet resignation fear, even acceptance among their number. Much of the first half of the book focuses solely on a pair of leaders tracking down murder, the consequences of his actions and the disintegration of even the most basic signs of trust that once existed. Instead of just rushing into things, he takes advice from the Traitor to use violence just the way it really needs to, rather than turning into a pure bolter. However, as we see everything from a legion of serfs to former centurions reflecting on their bloody nature, it is to avoid the mistake of a traitor turning them into a broken legion joke. Even on the verge of destruction here, time to still show that they are exceptionally capable fighters without going completely nuts with it. Many of the book's most memorable moments stem from two aspects. First, while still eventually a Warhammer tale, there are some surprisingly effective horror trails at work here. While far from influenced by Joe Parrino's story, Reynolds is another author to try to tell a horror story with astartes, and manages to get it right. This is largely due to aspects found among crew members, especially Skoral medics, who find themselves on the receiving end of an outbreak of violence more than once. In these moments, the tale emulates some of the best aspects of slasher movies or aliens in these moments, and it helps make their hostile nature all the more clear. Even if it's Legionnaires serving as the main characters of the tale, it makes it very obvious what kind of monsters they really are at the same time giving you reason to root for them. It also helps to better highlight losses and after Terra, all the time cranked crank tension among the characters. Speaking of the characters themselves, the Eater of the Worlds takes an unusual angle with Hearn. He's on the cover, he's in the title, but that's what we never see in his head. Instead, we see it through the eyes of others, often legionnaires, as he gradually narratively transforms into a living legend. Instead of following examples in recent years, what we here seem to follow the older approach the Black Library once took with its big-name characters. Using competent, capable samples of certain forces as symbols of the point of view, it raises the characters on the table to new heights. They are incredibly proficient in the art of killing, but Hearn is the league above them, and thanks to this the reader helps to get a better impression of something less human and a more lively avatar of war. We only get bits and pieces about Betrayer himself, but this is presented in enough way to keep you invested rather than feeling cheated by any interesting pieces. As always, however, for every force there is a failure of some kind, and the Eater of the Worlds has its fair share. The most prolific of these is that, while boasting a wide and diverse ensemble of characters, the novels struggle to balance them. Each has an interesting story for them and background information, and yet too often many of them are pushed far away in the background. On top of this, without some true introductions and restrictions on weakening the reader in detail of who's who, the characters unfortunately begin to blur together. While Skoral, Bronnd, Gallerius, Dreagher, and Sam Hearn obviously all stand out, others can be hard to keep up with at times. This unfortunately hurts the tale badly as it lays the groundwork for a potentially outstanding series, but it's so crammed here that even the focus of the characters just doesn't give enough chance to shine. Instead, they seem too similar to archetypes and ideas, rather than symbols in themselves. Another problem also stems from the novel walk. While setting up to later events and using violence surprisingly sparingly, there are some surprisingly dense scenes of dead air during the first half. The fact that the Eaters of the World is doomed, again and again rammed the house, that without something to unite them, they are as good as the dead, but lacking drive to it. The initial hunt helps to emphasize this to the point, but after that too many scenes seem as if they leak. An interesting diversion to be sure, but it is becoming more repetitive to the end. Then, of course, there is the problem of the structure of history. Much of this seems to rely on the reader already having some significant awareness of setting up, events heresy and what will follow. It's the middle of a fairy tale, after from Terra, but stopping Before the front some really frustrating continued bullying, and if you're not familiar with events it can be hard to keep up. In addition, the story also ties heavily to Horne's chosen, with many of the same characters and even themes emerging. This seems to have been written at least in part to serve as a prequel, and without this grounding some of the meaning behind a few twists can be lost on readers. This, of course, not to mention the fact that the aforementioned continuation of bullying leaves the tale very open ended. We don't see the fate of many characters and there are still many plot streams left dangling. That's enough to create something solid for the series, and makes me really hope we get one, but as one lonely story it just lacks the closure a casual reader would like. In addition, there is a cover. To be honest, it may seem like a petty gripe, but after Horne's favorite image of him on the cover looks cartoonish. Hearn is hardly a model of subtlety, but we've seen much better with it done many times, and it's only gotten worse compared to the wonderfully illustrated Legionnaires decorating the book back. With all this good and bad, however, Hearn: The Eater of the Worlds turns out to be an entertaining book that stays on the eye above the usual bolter. Fans of The Chaos space Marines will certainly get a kick out of this story, and it provides far more content than the average hard back story the Black Wheel Library is out. While primarily presenting the potential to run the series, it nonetheless does enough to keep you wanting to read through and helps flesh out that little bit more. As something to help bridge the gap between the Jerus Erus and the Black Legion series, you can easily do much worse than that. ... More...
