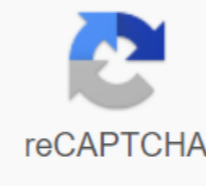




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Challan 281 pdf form

In 2004, the manual tax collection process was replaced by the online tax accounting system (OLTAS). It was introduced to minimize human intervention, thereby reducing errors and facilitating the online broadcast of details collected, deposited, returned, etc. OLTAS releases a single copy of Challan and allows taxpayers to track the state of their challans or electronic challan deposited in banks online. There are three types of challans that are issued: a. Challan ITNS 280 – issued for income tax (includes self-assessment tax, upfront tax, regular assessment tax) b. Challan ITNS 281 – issued for the tax deducted from the source (TDS) and the tax collected in source (TCS) c. Challan ITNS 282 – issued for gift tax, wealth tax, securities transaction tax (STT) and other direct taxes. 2. Compliance requirements for Challan ITNS 281 Challan ITNS 281 issued when taxpayer deposits TDS and TCS. Thus, it must comply with the deadlines set out for the deduction and tax. Tds 1 payment dates. TDS is deducted from payments (excluding property purchases): on the 7th of the following month. 2. TDS is deducted when buying property: on the 30th of the following month. 3. TDS is deducted in March of the month: April 30. In the event of a delay in the tax, interest is charged at a rate of 1.5% per month or part of the month from the date of deduction. 3. The process of filing Challan ITNS 281 there are two processes to file Challan ITNS 281: Online Process Offline Process Go to the Tin-nsdl website and choose Challan No. ITNS 281. At the time of tax payment, the following details must be filled out in Challan ITNS 281. Select deductees: Choose the appropriate deduction i.e. on behalf of which payment was deducted. There are two options: 0020: Company deductees 0021: Non-company deductees Score of the year (AY): Appropriate AY for which payment is made. For example, if the payment is made on June 30, 2017 (i.e. for FY 2017-18), the corresponding AY will be the 2018-19 Tax Deduction Account Number (TAN): TAN is a 10-digit alphabet number issued to individuals who are required to deduct or collect tax. Payment type: 200: must be selected if TDS/TCS is a regular transaction 400: must be selected if payment is made for a claim raised by income tax authorities. Payment character: The section under which TDS/TCS has been deducted must be selected from the dropdown list. Details of the payment: Enter income tax, surcharges and late filing fees (if applicable). must also be entered along with the date and branch of the bank. After filling out all the details, click on the submit to the bank and you will be redirected to your bank's portal to process the payment. Once the transaction has been successfully processed, the challan counter is displayed CIN number, payment details and the name of the bank through which the electronic payment was made. Offline process for the offline process, the taxpayer can make a payment by personally visiting the bank and submitting challan. It should be noted that payment can be made through a check or cash. According to challan' submission, the bank will issue a counterfoil receipt back stamped as proof of submission. 4. However, the process is used for a few bugs to appear every now and then. To put an end to stupid mistakes, an online tax accounting system or OLTAS have emerged! In general, OLTAS is responsible for collecting, accounting and receiving reporting and paying direct taxes. In the old days, three different specimens of the challan were produced. But, after OLTAS, one copy is issued along with a tear strip, called challan 281. What is Challan ITNS 281? This was back in 2004, when the online tax accounting system replaced the manual tax collection process. The purpose of the system was to reduce human intervention, thus minimizing errors and facilitating the online transmission of information about the collected, presented, returned and more. With the only copy of challan that OLTAS issues, it becomes easier for taxpayers to track the status of electronic challan or challan deposited in banks. There are three different types of challans that usually get issued: Income Tax Challan 280: It is for the deposition of income tax Challan 281: This one for making a tax is deducted from the source and tax, collected in the source of income tax Challan 282: This one is for making a wealth tax, gift tax, securities, transaction tax and other types of direct tax compliance for Challan No. 281 Challan 281 issued when taxpayer deposits- tax collected at the source (TCS) or tax deducted from the source (TDS). Thus, they will have to comply with the terms mentioned for deduction as well as taxation. The last TDS payment date is usually: TDS on payments (except for property purchases): 7th of next month TDS to purchase real estate: on the 30th of the following month TDS is deducted in March: April 30. If the tax deposit is delayed, interest of 1.5% per month will be charged from the date of the deduction. How to file Chalan 281? There are two different and simple ways to serve challan 281: 1. If you submit challan 281 online, follow the steps below for Process: Visit the tin-nsdl website on the homepage, look for Challan No./ ITNS 281 and click continue the Redirected window will open the form you have to fill out in 30 minutes Now select the necessary options and fill in columns with relevant information After you have filled out all the details, enter Captcha click on Proceed; You will then be redirected to the Bank's portal for the payment process. Once the transaction has been successfully processed, you will display a receipt with payment details, a CIN number, and the name of the bank through which you made the electronic payment. 2. Offline process As for the offline process, you will have to make a payment in person by visiting the bank and submitting your challan. If you make a payment through cash or check, you should take note together. After submitting challan, the bank will issue challan receipts with a stamp on the back as proof of submission. How can you check the status of TDS Challan? If you want to keep track of your TDS Challan status, you can easily do so online. Visit the TIN-NSDL website To hover over the service menu and select the Challan Status Request The new tab will open where you can choose either CIN Based View (Challan Based View) or TAN Based View If you choose CIN Based View, you will have to enter details of your challan available on the issued receipt and if you choose TAN Based on view, you only have to enter the account number What is the number? A: TDS is deducted tax at source, and the central government collects it. 2. Who pays TDS? A: TDS is a tax paid by a person or organization for rent, commission, salary, professional fees, wages, etc. 3. When is Challan ITNS 280 issued? A: ITNS Challan 280 is issued for income tax. Chalan is applicable for self-assessment tax, pre-tax and regular assessment tax. 4. What is the year of the tax deduction assessment? A: The year of valuation or AY comes after the fiscal year or FY. Income earned during FY is valued and taxed. However, both AY and FY start april 1 and end on March 31. For example, FY 2019-20 and AY 2020-21 are the same. 5. What are the different types of payment? Some of the sources of income that may fall under TDS are: Wages Interest On Securities Prize Money Contract Payments Insurance Commission Brokerage Commission Transfer Real Estate 6. How to download TDS paid Challan 281? A: To check the state and download the paid Challan 281 TDS, you will have to log on to the Income Tax Department website. After that, you will have to provide the TAN number, fill in the necessary details. Once you have provided detailed information, you can check the state of Challan and This is. 7. What is the deadline for paying TDS? A: TDS must be paid by the 7th of each month. For example, for April, May and June, the quarter ends June 30, TDS must be paid on May 7, June 7 and July 7. 8. What is the difference between Challan 280 and 281? A: Chalan 280 is generated to pay income tax. Challan 281 is generated to pay taxes deducted from the source. 9. Can I pay TDS offline? A: Yes, you can pay FOR TDS offline, but for this you will have to contact the bank where you have an account. After that, you will have to discuss the TDS payment method available with the bank. 10. How is the TDS penalty calculated? A: The TDS penalty is calculated based on each tax you withhold when you pay. It is calculated as long as the fine is not equal to the amount you have to pay as tax. 11. Who is filing a TDS refund? Answer: TDS returns are submitted by an employer or organization paying TDS. Aside from that, anyone who pays TDS must file for TDS returns. Conclusion Keep in mind that TDS challan 281 is a necessary receipt when you are willing to pay taxes. So, whether you choose offline method or online, don't forget to keep tab on challan to track if your tax got accepted.
