CMT Site #14 Comment Submittal: The TKPOA has asked Lahontan to approve the move of one "herbicide/UV-C combo" site (#14). This was requested as part of our APAP (aquatic pesticide application plan). One notable benefit of the proposed change would be a material reduction in the size of "restricted test area A."

It'd be greatly appreciated if you could submit a comment to Lahontan supporting our requested relocation of "combo site" #14. There is a 30 day comment period. The Lahontan Water Board will accept written comments on the amendment to the APAP until 5:00 pm on April 1, 2022.
