Rowling's first adult novel, a British author, famous, first and pramosm, for being the creator of the Harry Potter book series. Of the 512 pages (608 in Spanish translation by Gemma Rovira and Patricia Antoun), the novel was released on September 27, 2012, but before its release the book had accumulated more than a million orders. The plot chronicles the clashes and disagreements that arise because of a vacancy in the parish council in a small English village. The novel was received by critics with mixed reviews. Michiko Kakutani of the New York Times finds it so intentionally banal, so depressingly stereotypical, that it's not only disappointing, but also boring. Theo Tate of The Guardian accuses him of resorting to type situations and clichés and claims that while she is ambitious in her subjects, she is definitely a routine in her style. For Leo Grossman, on the other hand, Time magazine, it is a great novel of modern England, ambitious, brilliant, irreverent, funny, deeply sad and superbly expressive. Meanwhile, Harry Potter-Rowling fans didn't wait for Salamandra to edit the novel in Spanish, and in September began a collective translation project. Salamandra, meanwhile, will advance the release of the new work, which was scheduled for 2013, to December 19, simultaneously in Spain and Latin America, both on paper and digitally. In 2015, HBO made an unexpected, tv miniseries based on the novel. The adaptation was made by Sarah Phelps and broadcast on the BBC. The novel focuses on topics such as domestic violence, self-harm, unsafe sex among teenagers, alcoholism, drug addiction, smoking and bullying, among others.
