1) Description:

The purpose of this proposal is to train the teachers in public schools and community learning centres in all the 774 local government areas and 128,000 villages of the Federal Republic of Nigeria on the effective use of the Kick Out Malaria educational materials, that's Kick Out Malaria Storybooks, Story Apps and Computer Video Games.

2) Goals:

1. Advocate cleanliness through behavioural change.
2. Help children adopt a healthy lifestyle for their well-being.
3. Teach positive attitudes towards tackling environmental pollution for the common good.
4. Groom informed climate change agents that will act as catalysts for a clean, greener and healthier nation.
5. Raise heroes who will influence other children to act as a force towards eradicating malaria in Nigeria.

3) Objectives:

1. To train teachers/guardians on the effective use of the Kick Out Malaria educational materials (Storybooks, Story Apps and Computer Video Games).
2. To monitor the performance of the children/students on the learning outcome of the Kick Out Malaria educational materials, which is to live a healthy life and keep a clean environment.
3. To evaluate the impact of the Kick Out Malaria educational materials and training in the lives of the children and their communities.

These materials and tools are the properties of each school/community engaged and to be used for training purposes only. 5.1) PROJECT DIRECTOR

Trust Fund (LSETF)'s Lagos Innovates workplace voucher beneficiary (2019) – Lead-A-Leap started as a project to enhance children's learning in the classroom and improve their learning outcome through the production and distribution of quality learning materials to early-grade schools.
