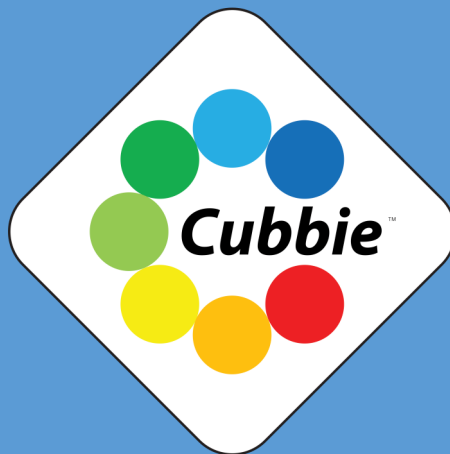

Cubbie Sensory Hub Case Study

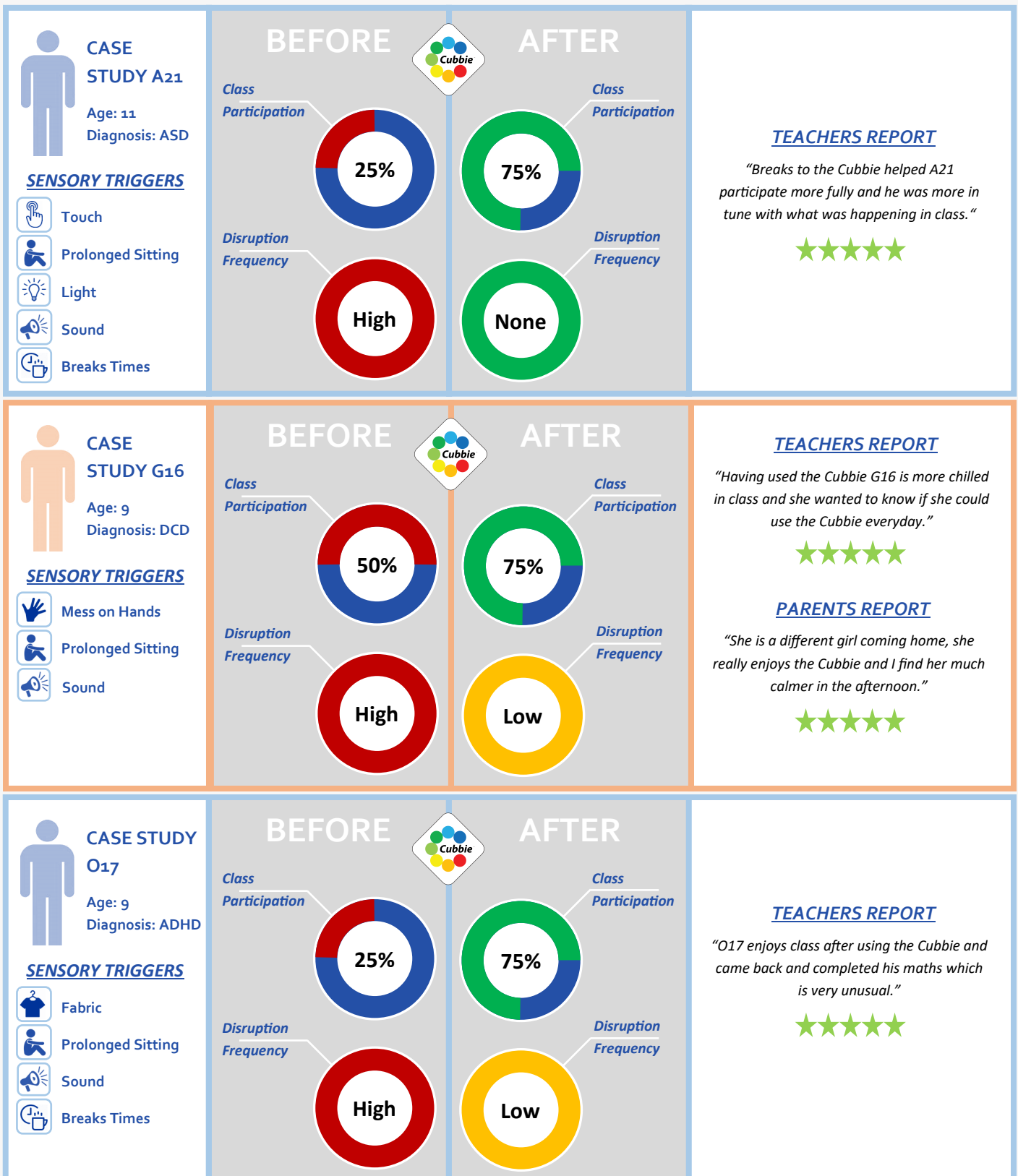
The Cubbie Sensory Hub is a sensory management system designed for educators who wish to actively support their staff, students and Parents.


Unlike Multi-sensory rooms the Cubbie is proactive and results driven, providing an Occupational Therapist designed sensory experience to students with the touch of a button.

The universal design supports student wherever there is a Cubbie installed. This allows each user to download their sensory programme, ensuring continuity of care unmatched by other systems.
