ISPA Japan Young Mariner Program was initiated in Australia in 2017.
This is our first tall ship young mariner course in Japan.



MIRAIE

Three-masted topsail schooner with overall length of 52 meter. Osaka city has operated the ship as a sail training vessel from 1993. In 2014, the ship was commissioned as MIRAIE.

Cross-cultural experience

The voyage will be composed of Japanese and non-Japanese youths age 15-25. The diverse crew will enjoy learning about their cultures and life experiences, while working in watch teams, side-by-side. Training will primarily be in English.

ISPA certification

Instruction regarding the knowledge and techniques required to operate a tall ship will be provided. The participants receive a workbook for reference. Prior to the program, a pre-boarding orientation will be conducted. Upon completion, of the voyage, the ISPA Tall Ship Novice Crew and/or Competent Crew certification will be awarded.

Teamwork & Leadership

A watch system will be implemented, where groups of youths will work under the watch leader to operate the tall ship alternatively throughout the voyage. It is an opportunity to foster friendships and learn the importance of teamwork by working toward common objectives. It is also an opportunity to learn important leadership skills; critical thinking and decision making required for ship operation.

Motivation and Self-discipline

All the participants will have limited personal space (i.e. berth), personal effects and time. The practice of organizing these limited resources will help build self-discipline. This habit will prove very useful throughout life when demands mount!

Age: Ages 15 to 25 only.

Participation fee: ¥100,000 (plus tax, including all meals)
