



ADOPTION & FOSTER-TO-ADOPT FORMS

Thank you for having an interest in adopting from P3. In order to save you and us time, please read the following frequently asked questions before filling out our application.

FAQ:

- **What is included in an adoption?**
 - All dogs will be Spayed/Neutered, microchipped, up to date on their yearly required shots and will have a 30-day flea treatment.
- **How much is the adoption fee?**
 - Adoption fees can vary on adult dogs depending on intake factors. Their profile should show their price, but the standard cost is \$150- \$300. Please reach out to us if you do not see an amount on their profile before filling out an application.
 - Puppies are \$200 unless otherwise stated. Please see the next question for an explanation.
- **How do you come up with the adoption fee?**
 - Many of our animals come to us in bad situations, and they more than often have some type of medical issue which requires us to pay for vet visits and medications they may need. They may also need special training, boarding, treatments, grooming, etc.
 - The dogs all need food/milk, toys, beds, and potty pads. Depending on the age and situation, average daily costs for a dog can range from \$10-15 for adult dogs to \$25-35 for puppies.
 - We do not get government funding to help us lower our costs for any medical needs including vet visits, shots, and spay/neuter.
 - All adoption fees include; 3 or 4 DHPP shots (varies by animal), Bordetella, a rabies vaccine, flea treatment, microchip and the spay/neuter. Plus, any other medical the dog needed.
 - Puppy packs can cost you \$400-\$500 not including spay/neuter. Spay/neuter can cost anywhere from \$400-\$700 depending on gender/breed/weight. With our adoption, your dog won't need any more required shots for another year, and they will be spayed/neutered.
- **How long will it take for me to hear back from you? And what's the process?**

We always try to get back to you in 24-48 hours. Please remember, we are volunteers. The best-case scenario is to read the application, fill it out, give us a call to tell us you are interested in meeting a dog and we can look up your application. If there are no other details that need to be discussed, we can then set up a meet and greet. If the meet and greet goes well, we will then start the adoption process and take the adoption fee. Most dogs can go home the same day.
- **What is the Foster to Adopt program?**

P3 Foster-to-Adopt Program was created to place unaltered animals into approved forever homes in a foster/partner situation prior to adoption. The Foster-to-Adopt Program allows approved applicants to take an unaltered dog into their home until the dog is old enough or healthy enough to be spayed/neutered by a licensed veterinarian. If the Foster-to-Adopt family is accepted, they will foster/be a partner in the dog until it is altered, then the adoption contract will be finalized.

There is no guarantee as to the health, temperament, breed or ultimate size of any animal. The adopter assumes the responsibility to take the animal to a veterinarian of their choice and continue regular checkups and vaccinations. Paws, People, and Purpose, Animal Rescue and Advocacy Foundation WILL NOT aid with diagnosis, treatment, management or medical expenses once the animal is adopted.

I am at least 18 years of age and, as the lawful adopter of said animal, I agree:

- ☐ There is no guarantee of the breed, health or temperament of the animal I am adopting, and I release BAARC from and all claims of liability.
- ☐ I agree to keep the animal in good health. I will provide routine health care, including but not limited to vaccinations, internal and external parasite prevention and general visits to a vet to ensure proper maintenance.
- ☐ If, for whatever reason, I cannot keep the animal, I agree to inform P3 immediately. P3 reserves first right to reacquire the animal. **I UNDERSTAND THE ADOPTION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.**
- ☐ Animals will not be left unattended, tied, or chained up as a means of securing the animal. The animal will sleep indoors at night, unless otherwise agreed upon.
- ☐ P3 retains the right to repossess the animal at any time, if there is any evidence of neglect or abuse, or if P3 has good reason to believe that the home is not in the best interest of the animal or the owner.
- ☐ I give P3 permission to call or visit my home at any reasonable time to assure that the animal is being properly treated and cared for.
- ☐ I understand that my animal has had all its initial, age-appropriate vaccinations. I also agree that I am responsible for any remaining vaccinations, including rabies, if it has not been received yet. If the animal is under 6 months of age, I understand that more vaccinations may be required, and I agree that I will provide these vaccinations at my own expense.
- ☐ I understand and agree that it is my responsibility to assume all risks of the animal's guardianship, including all costs incurred and risk of injury to myself and others after adoption. **P3 WILL NOT** aid with diagnosis, treatment, management or medical expenses of this animal once the adoption is final.
- ☐ I agree that the animal is being adopted for myself and will not be sold, adopted out or given to another party.
- ☐ I agree to keep P3 informed of my current home address and phone number.

FOSTER-TO-ADOPT CONTRACT

(Puppies and Unaltered Dogs)

In order to be accepted into this program, Foster-to-Adopt applicants must have an approved application. In addition, applicants must sign the Foster-to-Adopt Agreement which requires compliance with all the Foster-to-Adopt terms and conditions, including the adoption procedures.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND INITIAL EACH PARAGRAPH

I understand that:

1. P3 is entering this Foster-to-Adopt Agreement as a courtesy to me to allow me to have custody of this dog until it can be spayed/neutered; _____
2. P3 has a strict policy that all dogs must be spayed/neutered at a veterinary hospital before an adoption can be completed; _____
3. I must comply with P3 policies concerning this dog while the dog is still in the Foster-to-Adopt program; _____
4. I agree to pay the adoption fee at the time of the signing of this agreement; _____

In the Foster to Adopt Program with P3, with the intention of adopting the fostered dog, I agree to comply with the following conditions and requirements:

- ☐ P3 and I will be PARTNERS in the dog until it has been spayed/neutered and the adoption is finalized. If, for any reason, the adoption is not finalized, I understand that P3 will reclaim the dog and the adoption fee will NOT be refunded.
- ☐ I will provide the dog with good care, including but not limited to, proper food, fresh water, shelter, exercise, grooming, training and medication when required.
- ☐ I will comply with all instructions received from P3 and will not deviate from any instructions as to the care and maintenance of the dog without consulting with a representative of P3.
- ☐ I agree to maintain the dog as my own household pet and companion.
- ☐ I agree to comply with all Missouri State Laws and local ordinances applicable to the dog.
- ☐ I agree not to abandon, trade, give away or sell the dog. Nor is the dog to be used or sold for commercial use or research purposes. If I no longer desire or are unable to keep the dog within the terms of this agreement, the dog must be returned to P3. The dog is NEVER to be turned over to an animal shelter or passed to another owner without consent from P3.
- ☐ I agree to keep the dog under my control and not let the dog roam freely outside of the home or fenced yard. Keeping the dog on a chain, rope, dog run or similar device is not permitted.
- ☐ I will provide a safe and loving home environment and will socialize the dog to humans and other animals. Dogs are not to be excessively crated (not more than a total of 6 hours in a 24-hour period).
- ☐ I will provide basic training or reinforcement of proper house manners and obedience skills. This training and reinforcement will be done only by positive reinforcement. At no time, will the Foster-to-Adopt home use punishment as a training tool.



- ☐ I agree to properly supervise the dog at all times. I will be physically present when the dog is allowed outside in a fenced area and/or leashed.
- ☐ I agree to the following regarding veterinary care:
- ☐ I have been provided with veterinary records that show the dog has received appropriate veterinary care to date and is in good health, except for the following medical conditions about which I have been informed:

 - ☐ If the dog needs medical attention, a member of P3 must be contacted immediately and must approve all vet/emergency visits. Said visit must be with one of P3's approved vets. If an adopter takes a partnered pet to an unapproved vet for any reason, the adopter agrees to be responsible for all medical bills incurred.
 - ☐ P3 will make arrangements for the spay/neuter surgery. I agree that I will take the partnered dog to the spay/neuter appointment, or prearranged dropping off point, unless other arrangements have been made by mutual agreement. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to the requirement that the dog must be spayed/neutered before its adoption is complete. **There is a \$100 missed appointment fee.**
- ☐ As soon as the spaying/neutering of the partnered dog is completed, any necessary veterinary records will be forwarded to me. I agree that I am responsible for the cost of any veterinary care after this adoption is complete.
- ☐ This agreement is not transferable. If I am unable to care for the dog, I will immediately return the animal to P3.
- ☐ I give permission for P3 to enter my premises, upon reasonable notice, for determining whether I am complying with this Agreement, and to remove the dog if I violate the terms of this Agreement.
- ☐ I understand that other animals in my household could be exposed to medical or behavioral conditions that have not been recognized in the foster dog placed with me by P3, and that P3 is not liable for any disease or injury of my own companion animals or other exposed animals.
- ☐ I agree not to attempt to hold P3 responsible for any damages which the dog may do to any person or property. I specifically release P3 from any responsibility pertaining to any damage to property or personal injury and agree to notify P3 immediately of any damages and/or injury(ies).
