

1-Day Accra City Tour

***Pickup**

Jamestown Fishing Community

Start in Old Accra at Jamestown, one of the oldest districts. Walk through the colonial-era streets, see the lighthouse for great city/sea views, and visit James Fort Prison. Check out the vibrant boxing gyms and fishing harbor.

– Kwame Nkrumah Memorial Park & Museum

Dedicated to Ghana's first president. See his mausoleum, museum with personal effects, and the iconic statue. Learn about Ghana's independence story.

– Independence Square / Black Star Square

Right next door. Huge parade grounds with the Black Star Gate and Independence Arch. Quick photo stop and history chat.

– Osu Castle / Christianborg Castle

Former seat of government on the coast. Tour the grounds and hear about its slave trade + colonial history.

2:30 PM – W.E.B. Du Bois Centre

Home, library, and tomb of the famous Pan-Africanist. Peaceful grounds and powerful history on the African diaspora.

– Centre for National Culture / Arts & Craft Centre*

Market for wood carvings, kente, beads, paintings, drums. Great for souvenirs. Fantasy Coffin makers visit

- C-Kle Arts Gallery for authentic arts,

contemporary & traditional Ghanaian art in Teshie. One of West Africa's best private galleries.

Wrap up at Labadi Beach*

Optional quick stop for sunset, coconut, or live drumming if it's happening. Head back to hotel.
