



Asbestos Policy Statement 2020

Mattison Scaffolding Ltd shall hold management review meetings on a regular basis to monitor, review and revise our existing arrangements regarding the management of our policy and procedures in accordance with the '*Health and Safety at Work Act 1974*' and '*The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012*'.

All relevant statutory regulations and provisions as may be appropriate to reduce the risk of injury and harm to all persons who may be affected by our company asbestos related activities and operations.

It is the policy of the Directors of Mattison Scaffolding Ltd, that our asbestos related operations will reflect the highest degree of managerial efficiency, to promote and conduct our activities to the highest safety standards possible, and to provide adequate and sufficient resources to effectively apply our Policy and legal obligations in full.

It is to this end that continuous review and development of our company asbestos policy and procedures remains a primary management objective, to be pursued with a pro-active and positive safety culture involving the active participation and contribution of our employees.

All employees involved with our asbestos related activities, however employed and in whatever capacity, are expected to co-operate with the company in carrying out this policy and must ensure that their individual work duties and responsibilities is carried out without risk to themselves or others.

As Directors with primary responsibility to ensure that compliance with our policies and procedures remain practicable, achievable and effective, we have appointed a full-time Health & Safety Manager with duties to assist with this undertaking.

Our Health and Safety Manager and Senior Contracts Manager(s) will have particular responsibility and authority to advise and implement suitable and sufficient arrangements as deemed necessary to ensure high standards are maintained with regards to our health, safety and welfare issues in this respect?

Our Health and Safety Manager and Senior Contracts Manager(s) will remain available at all reasonable times and to whom reference should be made in the event of any difficulty, clarification or revisions as may be required to effectively and safely carry out the policy and procedures contained within this document.

The Directors of Mattison Scaffolding Ltd will monitor and review the safety arrangements, including the organisation and effectiveness of this policy, and have the authority to obtain the assistance and/or advice of independent consultants, as may be required, to satisfy our legal duties, obligations and responsibilities in full.
