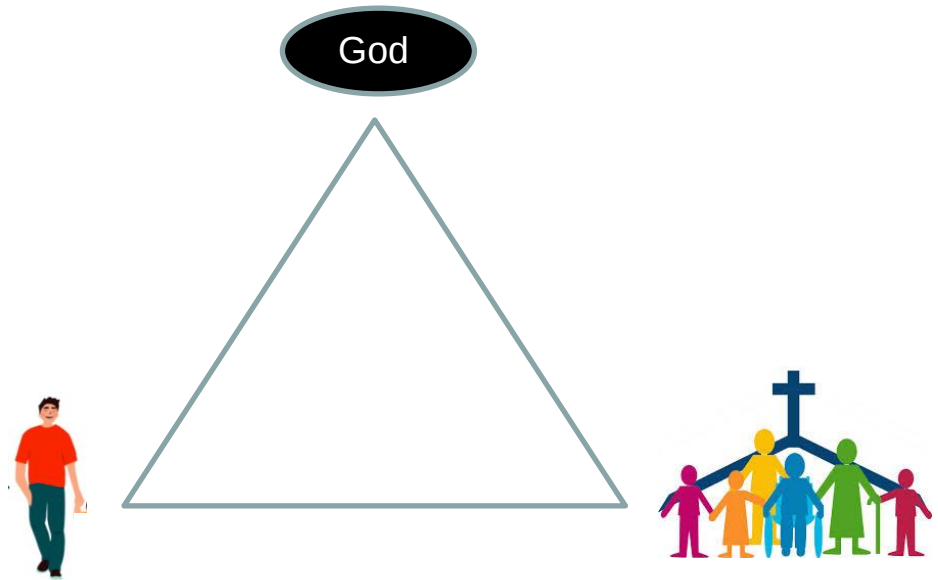

Don't Be Judgmental

Do not judge one another, and don't put a stumbling block in a brother's way

Romans 14:3 *Don't let him who eats despise him who doesn't eat. Don't let him who doesn't eat judge him who eats, for God has received him.*

Romans 14:1-6 *Now receive one who is weak in faith, but not for disputes over opinions... Who are you who judge another's servant? To his own lord he stands or falls...*

One man esteems one day as more important. Another esteems every day alike. Let each man be fully assured in his own mind.

He who observes the day, observes it to the Lord; ... He who eats, eats to the Lord, for he gives God thanks.

Romans 14:13 *Therefore let's not judge one another any more, but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block in his brother's way, or an occasion for falling.*

The most important thing we should do is to focus on our faith

in all things, charity
