

## Introduction

Purpose: to behave the way that God wants us to in our horizontal relationship one with another

1 Timothy 3:15 but if I wait long, that you may know how men ought to behave themselves in the house of God, which is the assembly of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.





### **Greet one another**

A Christian is part of the church - 1 Cor 12:26-27 When one member suffers, all the members suffer with it. Or when one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.


## Comfort one another

# Don't Be Judgmental

Do not judge one another, and don't put a stumbling block in a brother's way

Romans 14:3 Don't let him who eats despise him who doesn't eat. Don't let him who doesn't eat judge him who eats, for God has received him.

Romans 14:1-6 Now receive one who is weak in faith, but not for disputes over opinions... Who are you who judge another's servant? To his own lord he stands or falls...

One man esteems one day as more important. Another esteems every day alike. Let each man be fully assured in his own mind.

He who observes the day, observes it to the Lord; ... He who eats, eats to the Lord, for he gives God thanks.



Greet one another Comfort one another Pray for one another Romans 14:13 Therefore let's not judge one another any more, but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block in his brother's way, or an occasion for falling.

The most important thing we should do is to focus on our faith

Matthew 5:16 Even so, let your light shine before men; that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.






