

Stewart received a master's degree from Stanford University and a doctorate from the University of Toronto in 1967. He also worked for two years as a Graduate Student at the University of London. Stewart's research focused on harmonic analysis and functional analysis. Stewart is best known for his series of textbook calculations used in secondary education (secondary school) and college-level courses. His books are standard texts in the universities of many One of his most popular works is The Calculation of the Variable: Early Transcendence. Stewart was also a violinist, a formal member of the Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra. A curious point about Stewart's taste for violins and and this is reflected in the covers of his works: most of them represent the image of the violin, with a detailed form of resonant holes, which these musical instruments often commonly call eses or efes intentionally causing the form of the sign of integration, the symbol that defines the operation of integral calculation. In the foreword to some of his books, Stewart commented on the work of another renowned mathematician, the Hungarian George Pólya, to whom Stewart had respect and admiration, especially for the dedication that Pólya invested in teaching people how to solve math problems and which he tried to explain in his work How to Solve It. Stewart himself put some painstaking effort into trying to explain the step-by-step resolution procedures in his books, a characteristic that probably influenced their student admission. Stewart has also been an LGBTI rights activist since the early 1970s and has often talked about the relationship between music and mathematics. In the summer of 2013, Stewart was diagnosed with multiple myeloma, a type of blood cancer. He died in December 2014 at the age of 73.
