Aree took the membership class and joined the church.

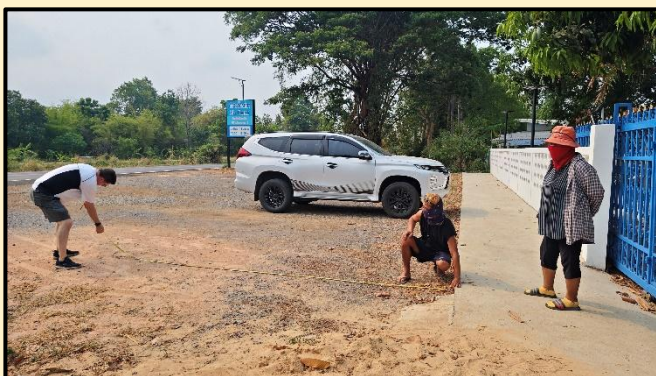

From the Pastor:

We thank God for His continued faithfulness this April and for your prayers and support. It has been a very hot month here in Khon Kaen, yet the Lord has continued to open doors for ministry. We were especially grateful to celebrate the fifth anniversary of the church. By God's grace, 68 people attended, including 13 first-time visitors. Many of them have expressed a desire to learn more about Christ, which has been a great encouragement.

We are seeing a growing hunger to understand the gospel and follow Christ. One new attendee shared a genuine interest in knowing what it means to become a Christian, reminding us that the Lord is still drawing hearts to Himself. We also welcomed a new member, Aree, who has joined us from Bangkok and desires to grow and serve alongside the church family.D

As the ministry continues to grow, we ask for prayer for discipleship. There are both new believers and regular attenders who are eager to learn, and we want to faithfully teach and guide them in following Christ. We were also thankful for opportunities to connect with families during the Songkran festival, showing simple acts of care and generosity to the children who regularly attend.

Looking ahead, we are planning to add a covered area for parking to help with the extreme heat. I have also applied for a Non-O visa and ask for prayer that the process would go smoothly, allowing continued ministry here. Thank you for standing with us in prayer and partnership. We are grateful for you and encouraged by how God continues to work through His people.
