December has left us humbled and deeply grateful for the work the Lord is doing here at Sila International Baptist Church. The highlight of the month was our Christmas outreach on Friday, December 26. We had planned for perhaps 200–250 people, but God brought more than 350. The space quickly filled, and many unbelievers heard the message of Christ. That night, more than 20 people stood to publicly say they had accepted Jesus and wanted to follow Him. Now begins the important work of follow-up, discipleship, and inviting them into the life of the church. Please pray with us for wisdom, strength, and faithfulness as we walk with these new believers.

We are tired – yet joyful. And we want you to know this: none of this would have been possible without your prayers and your generosity. Your support made this outreach possible. Because you gave, the gospel was preached. Because you prayed, hearts were opened. We truly labored together.

As we look ahead, we see both great need and great opportunity. God is clearly at work in our community, and the harvest is plentiful. My prayer is to be able to serve here fully – giving my time, strength, and focus completely to this ministry. We trust the Lord to provide what is needed, and we invite you to prayerfully consider standing with us as monthly financial support partners in this work.

Please continue to pray that believers would mature in Christ, that the church would grow in depth and faithfulness, and that the gospel would spread throughout our neighborhood and city.
