

Arpeggios are very effective in lead guitar lines as they break down scale-based passages and add interest and variety to solos. This lesson will be devoted to minor arpeggios. Arpeggio can be used in guitar solos in any music. Rock and metal guitarists use arpeggios all the time, as do jazz guitarists. Even a blues guitar solo can be flavored with some arpeggio licks. An example of arpeggio-based blues licks are provided further down the page. We will also demonstrate how the sweep collection can be used to reproduce arpeggio's lead guitar lines. Small Arpeggios movable shapes and licks in this lesson we will look at some minor form of arpeggio. We will then provide some licks that have been created with arpeggio shapes, so you can get an idea of how they can be used. The following diagrams show the movable minor shapes of arpeggio. The root notes for each shape appear to be a blue circle. This means (for example) that if you position the blue notes on the chart above the G notes on the board, the arpeggio produced will be G minor arpeggio. Note that some of the forms of arpeggio include additional notes above or below the root notes. This allows you to expand your lines to include all available notes in this fretboard position. TAB is shown below. Remember that arpeggio forms don't all start on a root note. Choice directions have been included to show how the sweep collection can be used to reproduce arpeggios. Sweep Choice ArpeggiosSweep collection is a method in which notes on two or more adjacent strings are played with a single punch pick. The choice moves smoothly along the strings in one continuous motion. For example, the first four lick 1 notes below all play with the same downward blow. The 'n' marking over the notes represents down the passages. The 'v' label denotes strokes. When collecting a sweep, only a note selected should be allowed to sound. Threading fingers should be positioned ready to play notes, but should only let the string ring when they are chosen. If the notes can overlap, the effect will be lost and the line will sound like strumming. Because sweeping collection is commonly used in fast passages, aisles, requires good coordination between picking and carving your hand.
