Trusted helpers misuse funds or assets.

How to Spot

Unexplained withdrawals, missing valuables.

How to Handle

Audit accounts; involve another family member.

Funeral/Bereavement Scams

Scammers target grieving families.

How to Spot

Fake debts or fees tied to obituaries.

How to Handle

Verify all bills; work with trusted funeral home.

Bogus COVID tests, wheelchairs, braces.

How to Spot

Cold calls or ads pressuring to buy.

How to Handle

Buy from Medicare-approved suppliers.

Insurance Fraud

Fake health or Medicare policies.

How to Spot

High-pressure sales, no clear paperwork.

How to Handle

Verify through Medicare.gov.

Home Repair Scams

Storm chasers, fake contractors.

How to Spot

Demanding cash upfront, no contracts.

How to Handle

Check licenses; never pay all upfront.

Property/Title Scams

Fraudulent liens or property transfers.

Sam's Take: Freeze your credit with all three bureaus.

How to Spot

Unfamiliar paperwork or mail.

How to Handle

Monitor title records; consult county office.

Search for the County Recorder for your county (search “Property Fraud Alert”)

Identity Theft *If multiple accounts are affected, see Identity Theft (companion guide).*

Stolen SSN or account data.

How to Spot

Unexplained bills or credit issues.

How to Handle

Freeze credit; use ID theft protection.

Work-from-Home Scams

Fake job offers with check fraud.

How to Spot

“Overpayment” and request to send money back.

How to Handle

Check job boards; never send money to employer.

Business Opportunity Scams

MLMs or get-rich-quick schemes.

How to Spot

Pressure to buy in, vague products.

How to Handle

Research thoroughly; check BBB.org.

SBA — Check a Franchise/Opportunity: <https://www.sba.gov>

Travel Scams

Fake vacation rentals or sweepstakes.

How to Spot

No verifiable address, upfront payment.

How to Handle

Use reputable travel sites only.

Timeshare Resale Scams

Fake brokers claim to sell timeshare.

How to Spot

Upfront “listing” fees requested.

How to Handle

Check state licensing; never pay fees upfront.

Contact Your State’s AG (For example, Florida) — Complaints/Help: <https://www.myfloridalegal.com>

Friend/Family Impersonation *Includes the classic Grandparent variation (see first guide for details)*

Hacked social accounts ask for money.

How to Spot

Messages out of character, urgent requests.

How to Handle

Call the person directly to verify.

Check/Cashier’s Check Scams

Overpayment or fake check schemes.

How to Spot

Request to wire back excess funds.

How to Handle

Wait for checks to clear; refuse odd payments.

How to Spot

Emotional, divisive, lacking credible sources.

How to Handle

Verify before sharing; check fact-check sites.

Fake charities linked to deaths.

How to Spot

Donation requests through unofficial channels.

How to Handle

Confirm charity legitimacy before donating.
