Ferguson, a 2019 pole vaulter at the Class 3A State Championships, gained 11 yards and finished fifth. A year earlier, Ferguson was the state runner-up and cleared 11 feet, six inches. WCHS track and field coach Tracey Sobolewski says she remembers when Ferguson decided she wanted to try pole vault during her freshman year and said she's amazed at how far she's progressed. The Woodford County High School track and field team ended its season with a terrific showing at the Class 3A Championship at the University of Kentucky Saturday afternoon. A few names to watch on Saturday: Callie Gormley and Esther Bradshaw in the 100 and 300 meters hurdles and Justin Lehmkuhler in the 110-meter hurdles high jump. Legend Burgess in shot put and discus, Kamari Black in the triple jump and Allison Allison in the pole vault. The WCHS girls softball team will face Boyle County at Berea College... The seeds and performance sheets are out for the track and field Class 3A State Championship June 1 at the University of Kentucky. The Track Jackets are well represented at the meet and have a handful of top-five seeds heading into next Saturday. Cassidy Gilbert, Caroline Murray, Katherine Crain and Abbey Bleuel are the 23rd seed in the girls 4x800 relay. Callie Gormley is the 11th seed in the girls' 100-meter hurdles, and Esther Bradshaw is seeded 12th in a field of 24. Justin Lehmkuhler is fifth in the boys' 110 meters hurdles. Esther Bradshaw, Adriana Jackson, Callie Gormley and Kamari Black are seeded seventh in the girls 4x200 relay.... * The list of individual qualifications for the Track Jackets will likely grow once all the regions have completed their meets.
