2021 Program Midline Results Show Tremendous Results and Real ROI

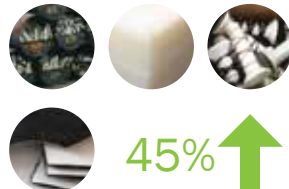

FDRA's Zero Waste Program is an industry-wide initiative aimed at eliminating manufacturing waste in shoe factories. It helps factories identify, sort, and recycle waste to keep it out of landfills, providing a critical tool to significantly increase sustainability at the factory level. Our teams do all the work with the factories for you. FDRA subsidizes the program to help cover costs for our members. We also collect key emissions and other ESG data at the factory level to help you track and trace your overall footprint.

The program results in 2021 show a near 69% reduction in factory waste headed to landfill or incineration. Building on our success, the program is now expanding to cover factories in both China and Vietnam for shoes and apparel.
