

Most compact cameras weigh around 1.3 pounds, and most digital SLRs weigh around 4.5 pounds. A camera body itself usually costs \$100 to \$200, which is cheaper than a lens. In late 2012, the Canon EOS 5D Mark III was released and offered three times the resolution of the Canon EOS 5D Mark II, increased dynamic range, and better image quality. The EOS 5D Mark III was Canon's first digital camera to incorporate an articulating LCD screen.[108] The screen could be rotated down so the photographer could frame the photo before taking it.
