# EMS - Vocabulary



**paramedic:** a person who is trained to give emergency medical care . (noun)



The **paramedics** helped the man who was in a car accident.



# EMS - Vocabulary



**ambulance:** a special vehicle used to take sick or injured people to the hospital. (noun)



The **ambulance** had to drive very fast to get the patient to the hospital.



# EMS - Vocabulary



**patient:** a person who receives medical care from a doctor, nurse, paramedic, etc... (noun)



The doctor has to see many **patients** during the day. (noun)





# EMS - Vocabulary



**first aid:** medical care given to someone as soon as possible for sickness or injury. (noun)



A lot of people learn **first aid** so they can help people that need it.

We use **a few/a little** when we don't have very many/much of something.

There are a few  
eggs in the nest.



He drank a little  
milk for breakfast.



We can only use **a few** with countable nouns and **a little** with uncountable nouns.

# Emergency on the Highway



Carla and Frank are paramedics that work the night shift for an EMS (emergency medical service) in New York City. Tonight has been very busy because it is New Year's Eve and many people have been out doing things tonight. It is almost 6:00 am, and they are making sure the back of the ambulance has everything it needs for the next workers that will come. Suddenly, they get a call on the radio from a 911 operator. There has been a car accident on the highway and they need an ambulance to go there and help.



# Emergency on the Highway



Carla and Frank quickly move to the front of the ambulance. Frank turns on the sirens and lights and drives very fast to the accident.
