

Toronui Accommodation Health and safety

Toronui Station is a working sheep and beef farm - as with all rural farm properties there are many hazards

People visiting a farm have a responsibility to take reasonable care that their actions (or lack of action) do not put themselves or others at risk. They must also comply with any reasonable instruction given by the farmer, as far as they're able to. (Worksafe NZ website)

Hazards include but not limited to as follows

- Ground conditions - uneven tracks and ground, shingle roads, tomos(deep holes), steep bluffs
- Water - river, creeks, boggy ground, waterfall
- Farm buildings, fencing and machinery
- Farm animals
- Weather - Toronui can have extreme weather conditions including high wind , snow in winter on higher ground and quick changes in temperature. (High country Farm)

You accept that you enter the property at your own risk. We take no responsibility for any injuries, accidents or loss of property occurring during your stay with us.

Children must be supervised at all times.

A First Aid kit and fire extinguisher are located in the cottage.

Cell phone coverage is limited at the cottage but depending on your service provider can be accessed at various locations on the property.

Sorry no pets or motorbikes allowed.

All walking access must be agreed on by the farm manager prior to leaving the cottage.

Please leave all gates as you find them.
