The Bergen County Division of Senior Services was established in 1966 under Federal Legislation of the Older Americans Act. The Division of Senior Services is the primary planning, coordinating and funding agency for senior programs and services, promoting the well-being, health and independence of Bergen County's older adults. The Division targets especially those vulnerable and in greatest social and economic need.

The Division also provides support to various community -based organizations that promote the well -being and independence of Bergen County's 200,000 older adults.

As the lead agency for the Bergen County's Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC), the Division helps older adults, individuals with disabilities over the age of 18, and their caregivers, access the complex, long-term care, community-based, health and human services.

Meals on Wheels

Bergen County Meals on Wheels is a program designed to enable homebound and disabled adults to remain in their community with independence and dignity. A nutritionally balanced meal is delivered to eligible individuals who are unable to prepare their own meals or shop for food, and do not have anyone to prepare meals or shop for them. There are a number of home delivered meal programs in Bergen County. Residents are served through government or non-profit agencies.

- Bergen County Resident
- Age 60 years and older; or age 18-59 with a disability and living alone
- · Homebound and unable to shop and/or prepare a nutritious meal for oneself
- Receives in-home assistance for no greater than 4 hours per day
- Does not require a special diet

Weekday meals, Monday – Friday. Clients have a choice between the Hot Meal Plan or the Frozen Meal plan:

- Hot Meal Plan: One hot meal delivered each weekday Monday Friday
- Frozen Meal Plan: Five fully cooked, flash frozen meals delivered once a week on a specified day.

Weekend meals are available for nutritionally high-risk clients only.

Contract suppliers in the bidding areas cannot charge more than the 20% coinsurance and any unmet yearly deductible for any equipment or supplies.

New Jersey Property Tax Relief Programs

Homestead Benefit

Homeowners who owned and occupied a home in NJ that was their principal residence of the previous year October 1st and property taxes must have been paid. Homeowners will be mailed applications after the end of the income tax filing season.
