Course Overview & Learning Outcomes:

The qualification will enable successful candidate to;

- Understand the importance of health and safety in the workplace and how risk assessment contributes to successful health and safety management, and accident and ill health prevention
- Outline in detail the stages and principles involved in risk assessment
- Apply hierarchies of controls, to control risk to an acceptable level
- Demonstrate risk assessment in practice, completing a suitable and sufficient assessment in the delegates’ own work processes

Supplementary Information

Guided Learning Hours: 20 hours, of which 14 will be classroom based. The remainder will be self-study (i.e. homework!) to produce the assignment.....

Assessment Format: this qualification has a two part assessment;

- ◆ Part 1 is a 30 question multiple-choice examination lasting 1 hour. Learners must achieve 20 out of 30 to pass
- ◆ Part 2 is a centre-set and marked assessment. Learners are expected to undertake a risk assessment, which will be internally set and assessed by both RedCat and HABC.

Candidate Requirements; this is a moderately challenging course, equivalent to A" level study. Candidates require good functional skills and a degree of academic ability, and the time and motivation to study outside the classroom sessions.

Venue: central Norwich, at our state-of-the-art No8 Thorpe Road training venue.
