Statement

The school recognises that the teaching of RSE (Relationship Sex Education) for secondary aged children and RHE (Relationship Health Education) for primary aged children is a sensitive issue for parents and for young people and should be approached with a keen understanding of these sensitivities. The school also recognises that as an educational setting we have a statutory duty to ensure that RSE and RHE provision within the school satisfies the requirements of the law. In meeting both these requirements the school has a balanced approach that is at once faithful to our sacred tradition, addresses the genuine and diverse needs of the young people in our care and meets not only the letter, but also the spirit of the law.

In the Junior School RHE is integrated into the Montessori Curriculum and occasionally supplemented through special sessions; and in the Senior school RSE is integrated into aspects of the Senior School curriculum through the reading of texts and discussions and in additional PSHE sessions and assemblies.

A detailed policy is available from the school upon request and we are happy to discuss this in more detail with parents. The school meets with parents when topics of particular sensitivity are being addressed in various parts of the curriculum. Additionally we encourage parents to speak to us openly about any concerns they may have.
