

I recently built a special home theater in my basement and moved speakers there. I also have a new receiver Onkyo 806. I'm not impressed with my new setup at all as I like the video part (Panny 4000 with 12' wide screen scope), audio is boring, it can go loud, but I'm missing something. I have an Ed A5-350 as my sub, which works great, but I feel like my speakers aren't up to the rest. My room is not acoustically treated though, so maybe this might partly be a problem, but overall I'm disappointed. I'm looking for opinions on the quality/cost dynamics of sound speakers, especially compared to Klipsch, Energy and such. I'm not sure if I should start seriously looking or is it just a treatment in the room. Any proposals will be appreciated. Thank you. No website, they belong to the API, which has Mirage and Energy in its lines. According to some Joe on their website, Athena is technically the same. I'm not sure; Marketing push for Athens seems to be the best level of purchase; sounds like a cheaper brand (which has wiped the floor with other brands at lower prices, confusing the consumer. I was looking for them, but what? Not to mention that their L-300 was one of the most beloved deals of high class loved Absolute Sound, bitchiest of all rags... Yes, Sound Dynamics has been replaced by Athena in the stable of API loudspeaker brands. Athena has been doing well, posting several speakers on Stereophile Featured Components lists. Thus, basically, Athena continues the tradition of sound dynamics. Do a search here and you'll see Athena well viewed. Joe? I believe he's a brand manager at API. No, it wasn't the guy's name, I used a non-specific name like Joe C.P. Or something. Hm.. Okay, I'm cool with the Athena thing, but I wonder if they were compared back-to-back for quality... I'm still suspicious; If the brand is really highly valued, why change? About! Sorry, I think it was Joe Joe Frazier from technical support. He said they had not been in production for 4 years. Kind of got my response from a review in Stereophile: I'm getting it now, but I'm still surprised. Athena audition speakers are brainchildren designers Gord Van Kessel and Carmine Gitto, the team responsible for the highly popular Energy Take 5.2 home theater system and the Sound Dynamics RTS Bookshelf Line. The sound dynamics have always been aimed at the lower end of the market, in terms of price. While Athena is sold at Best Buy, it is also carried by audio advisor. Check out Athena Technologies AS-B1. Soundstage.com reviewers for 2002. Compared to the highly regarded Axiom M3TI SE. And most people, even the current owners of Athena speakers, have yet to check out their S/P series speakers, which were their first products. Who knows why the API decided to end the sound dynamics. Regardless of the name, the API produces one The best speakers available around with its Athena, Energy, and Mirage lines. I believe Gord Van Van Also developed line Is An Energy Connoisseur. I have the energy of a Connoisseur of C-1 bookshelf speakers, and it's amazing. Cool. Thanks man! I just felt bad for them; my first thought was that they were killed by the economy. Hey, Athens looks great! Good for them, (and you) The best thing to buy was something on the homepage of Athena Technologies; marketing ad. I didn't want to ruffle feathers! Doing more research now, looking at s3/p3 combos, they look fantastic. And the audition series looks very close to SD's RTS line. Party for Wayne! Kevin, here's a review of Athena AS-F2, a top-of-the-line floor speaker in the audition line, from Stereophile. And here's a review for the Athena S/P series. Don't ruffle feathers. The most important thing about speakers is that they sound good to you. How much it costs and where they were purchased are really secondary. I mean, my energy C-1s were purchased by a massive merchant who also sells the Energy Veritas series. Oh, seeing and hearing the Sound Dynamics RTS series, Athena auditioning the series is a step up in my opinion. Maybe the name Sound Dynamics sounded too much like a white speaker-type monkier. I just purchased a set of 100s sound speakers (10 woofer and tweeter), they sound great, but you need snacking. I change the boxes to fit my Athens. I make them tall, slender towers with silver facades and black painted oak veneer. By the way, I love my Athens and recommend them to anyone in the budget ht.
