Examining the Household of Faith



This July, the Household of Faith will celebrate our 9th anniversary. We have come a long way since the beginning. My lesson this morning will review our journey as I will share my observations on our strengths and opportunities for growth.

As we examine our progress, there are so many things we can learn from James 1:23-25 - *"For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing."*

1. Be a doer. So many of us grew up in the church, reading, learning and hearing the word of God. While this is important, we should not just internalise the word in our hearts but also put it into action in our lives by touching lives.

2. Do not forget. We can look intently in the mirror when we apply the word of God into our lives. It is also easy to be distracted and forget to correct and make adjustments to our lives in order to do better.

3. Persevere. All good things require time and work. Success does not come quickly. If we hear the word, look intently, do not forget and persevere on, the Bible assures us that we will be blessed.

In my sermon this morning, I will take a hard look at our journey of 8 years. This year we will celebrate our 9th year. It is so important that we keep on reaching out and growing. There are several small churches that have fallen into a rut and failed to reach out or baptise the lost except for their children. They lost their mission and were content with just coming together Sunday after Sunday.

The Household of Faith must never follow suit. The letters to the 7 churches are a timely reminder for all of us to do better in 2026. Lets do it!


