CLUB NEWS

IMPROVEMENTS & MAINTENANCE UPDATE

The Facilities Management Committee would like to keep you informed about what's been happening during the past six months regarding maintenance and improvement.

MAINTENANCE - Earlier this year our main water heater tank was replaced with a new one. It was a big project to haul the heater itself, a 400-pound unit, from the street level upstairs to the second floor, and to hook it up for installation. This task itself saved the club several thousand dollars, since most of the work and installation was done by our own committee members.

In the women's 2nd floor restroom, the old, galvanized pipe riser supplying the cold water was completely plugged up. We had to open the wall, remove the old, galvanized pipe and replace it with copper pipe.

The outside lights on the roof were updated with energy conserving light bulbs, and the ballroom floor was rebuffed and new varnish was applied, per the maintenance schedule. Some of you have already noticed the outside perimeter walls have been painted, except the facade wall. While searching for painting contractors, we found one who is a member. He and his crew did the job at cost, and at this time, I personally and the committee, would like to thank MIKE MILAN for the wonderful job he did.

The upstairs suite has been cleaned up, repainted, and has had a few electrical and air conditioning issues fixed. It is now rented again and should bring in much needed funds to the Club. Thank you to our realtor and member Michael Verdone for getting this suite rented out.

IMPROVEMENT - The front facade of the building has not been painted yet because there are several cracks in the stucco, and the tiles are also showing cracks. We are investigating plans to properly open and fill the cracks, fixing them correctly. We are also researching the improvements to the four windows on the street level facade by enlarging and lowering them, so that people from outside can see our beautiful restaurant and vice versa. We are in the process of having drawings created by our Vice President, Architect Jack Matthews. This process will take some time and funds. Soon, once we determine the full cost, we might need to reach out to our loyal and generous members for some financial assistance.

As the Maintenance Committee Chair, almost every single day something comes up, and we are doing our best to address these issues. I would like to thank the committee members: Darrel Mero, David Sarracino, Luca Miranda, Thomas Colombo, Ryan Morrow, and our new addition, Pete D'Oliva.

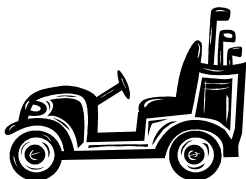

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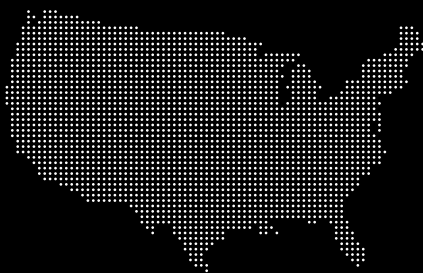


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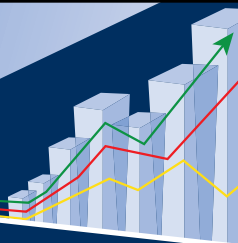
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
