

AP English Language and Composition Summer Test Prep Class

An 11-week summer session; one meeting per week

Saturday 6pm-8pm from 9/6- 11/15/2025

I. Purposes and Rationale of the Class

The Ivy College Guru's Dr. Gavin Wittje has designed this AP Language and Composition class to ensure that the attendants of this class will be able to take the exam and receive a 5 on the test.

With the inaccessibility or unavailability of AP English classes to juniors or sophomores in some schools, many juniors or sophomores are NOT allowed to take the AP English class at all, while these students are trying to increase their opportunities to receive higher AP Scholar Awards before they apply to colleges. So, this AP prep class is intended for both current and future AP Lang takers. You will have a slight edge if you are taking AP Lang in your school, but even if you are not taking the AP Lang class, you can and should still take the AP Lang test when available and can still score 5 with the help of this class. In the past, the vast majority of my AP Lang students received 5's on their AP Lang tests, while nationally only 9.1% of the AP Lang testing students received 5!

For some students who are taking AP Lang in school, their teachers in school do not specifically prepare the students for taking the AP Lang exam. As a result, many students in the past who finished AP Lang in school still failed to get 5 in their AP Lang test. While many of you are automatically taking AP Calculus and/or AP sciences and/or other AP classes and tests, not many of you are taking AP English tests. Top college admission officers have a stereotypical view about Asian American applicants: they take it for granted that you are good at the STEM areas but not good enough in English and Humanities and are therefore not well-rounded enough for leadership and for top colleges.

It is precisely to get you out of this Asian American stereotypical image that we offer this class, and we encourage you all to be excellent in English Language and Literature AP classes, just as you are excellent in your calculus and science AP classes.

II. Major Contents of the Class

The class will consist of the following specific contents and learning objectives:

- 1. Guided study, understanding, and memorization of all terminologies and nomenclatures of the English language and rhetoric that might be encountered in AP Language tests.
- 2. Careful study of AP Lang multiple-choice questions with an emphasis on reading comprehension and identifying the correct answers to the narrative passage questions encountered in AP Lang.

- 3. Development of specific strategies and stock approaches to questions for the three types of essay writing: Synthesis Essay, Analysis Essay, and Argumentative Essay.
- 4. Practice, practice, and lots of practice before your actual AP test. The class will have constant AP qestion practices so that you will be surely getting a 5 on the real test.
