Telescopic ladder, 2.3 m with bag, can be stowed in the tent




Kajto awning in a bag with 2 poles


Slider 1 and slider 2





Mounting set






Load tent onto the roof cross bar make sure each 2 bolts clamp the cross bar



Attach board to the slot, Fasten nuts make sure the board clamp the cross bar stable



Slider 1 and slider 2 slide into the mounting rail under the tent, one slider on either side of the crossbar.



Step by step

- Take tent out of the box and remove the plastic
- Prepare your 4 mounting sets and place tent in the right position on the top of the car
- Mount the tent to the cross bars, see previous page for instructions
- 1/ open the tent by loosening the set of 2 buckles and push one side up
- 2/ walk around the tent and loosen the next set of 2 buckles, push other side up
- Pull the skirt down around the edges
- Add the flex poles to the side entrances. Please note, the holes for the flex poles are at an angle. Push the pole in horizontally and bend to connect to the O-ring in the awning/door
- Close the tent in the reverse order: Remove flex poles first and put them in the bag, lift up the skirt around the edges to a vertical position and push the fabric into the tent. Don't close the zippers of the tent completely as air needs to be able to leave the tent. Tuck in fabric at the sides and pull one side down first. Don't forget to push the pulling cord in to the tent.
- Pull one side down first by pulling vertically in the middle of the tent. **Don't pull towards you as the top shell will shift position.** Close the buckles for 50% and walk around the tent to pull the other side down and close the buckles.
- Once the tent is folded, push the fabric into the tent. Push the pulling cords into the tent and close the buckles to 100% on both sides. Check all 4 buckles before you drive away.
- You can put the ladder, in the bag, into the tent or stow your ladder in the car. Blankets and pillows can stay, flat, in your tent
- And off you go!





Tips

- This is a single layer tent, always keep a door open slightly to allow ventilation in your tent to avoid condensation as much as possible
- After rain, make sure the mattress and tent are 100% dry, before you store the tent
- Like your car, this tent needs love and care. Please add some WD40 spray or silicon spray to all the bolts and nuts occasionally for a longer lifespan of the tent and parts. This is a must!
- Depending on the soil/ground you will be camping on, please think of bringing the right pegs for the mounting of the Kajto fly tarp
- The Kajto fly tarp has 2 telescopic poles and 4 ropes. If you plan on using the Kajto please consider bringing extra poles, ropes and/or quick release sail clamps for quick and easy set up
