

DSC SoftPhone & USB Phone Setup User Guide

Overview

Thank you for choosing DSC! This booklet provides an overview for DSC SoftPhone, USB Phone setup and DSC PC-to-Phone service.

DSC SoftPhone is a software application running on computers that synchronizes with USB Phone services such as SMD and SMDX. DSC SoftPhone provides a web-based telephone interface that facilitates your call processing and account management.

DSC USB and DSC SoftPhone are USB phones connected to your computer via a USB plug. They provide clear two-way quality allowing you to bypass the usual costs to avoid the possible duration when placing calls.

Supported by DSC TSP (Internet Telephony Service Provider) Network, you are able to place calls to any regular phone in the world with low rates or to other DSC USB devices such as GoldStar, GoldStarPro, iPlace, InterStar, InterPhone, IP20, IP200 or DSC SoftPhone.

Before You Start

Before your installation, make sure that your PC meets the minimum system requirements below.

- Windows ME, ML, 2000, XP or Vista
- Processor 300 or higher
- RAM 64MB or higher
- Available USB port
- CD-ROM drive
- 32 MB RAM
- Internet access
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.0 or later

Make sure you have the following:

- DSC SoftPhone software, which is included in DSC CD and also available on DSC's PC-to-Phone web site.
- DSC USB Phone SMD or SMDX
- A valid DSC TSP Account

Installation

Please install DSC SoftPhone software in your computer first. DO NOT connect DSC USB Phone to your computer unless your DSC SoftPhone is completely installed.

Step 1: Installing DSC SoftPhone

Insert the DSC CD into the CD-ROM drive of your computer. The setup wizard will start automatically.

Insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive of your computer. The setup wizard will start automatically.

I have gone to several [url= forums where this problem is rampant and still no answer to this problem. Using the 32-bit software driver, the output is just fine. I have spent 4 hours trying to find an answer, and posted on the [url= forum[url] this morning, but no luck. We have gone to their [url= page[url] to try and download the 64-bit drivers but they only have a select few drivers listed, none of which will work with Win 10. The links above are dead and not to be trusted. Pinnacle may have removed the Pinnacle.com website. Attached Files: Hi mikosteve Welcome to the forum. Most vendors have 64 bit drivers but only 32 bit drivers are available for download on the software page. I have tried to install the 32 bit driver myself to see if it would work for you and it installs without any problems. I do know a fellow who is having similar issues to you. I can't remember if he was able to resolve it or not. The best advice I can give you is to go to the Pinnacle forum, post what you've tried and the problem you are having. Someone may be able to help you over there. I had an upgrade from XP to 10 and had to reinstall drivers to get it to work. I have had this problem since the start of Win10. It will not let me buy the software online for Windows 10. I have Windows 8.1. I can buy the software on Windows 8.1 but it will not work with Windows 10. So the problem is still there. My driver was still in the legacy mode. I had to use the Win 10 install and re-install the drivers. I also have the same problem. After upgrading to Win 10, I can't buy the drivers on the Pinnacle website and I cannot download the 64bit driver from Microsoft website. I think it's a fault of Microsoft and Pinnacle. But I'm not sure. Welcome to the forum. Most vendors have 64 bit 520fdb1ae7
