Soon after, Rick uses his bike to return to his home and finds that his house has been looted and his wife and son (Lori and Carl) are both gone. After leaving his home, Rick was knocked unconscious by a shovel by a boy (Duane Jones). The boy's father (Morgan Jones) quickly tells rick that he is not a zombie, and bring him in. Rick wakes up and has dinner with Morgan and Duane. Morgan explains to Rick the nature of the outbreak and explains that it started a month ago. Rick learns that before the media shuts down, the government told everyone to move to big cities to protect them. Morgan later states that he thinks he will be safer away from the big cities. Rick decides that Lori will take Carl to Atlanta, where his parents live. Rick, Morgan and Duane go to the Cynthiana Police Department to get supplies. He gives Rick Morgan and Duane some guns and a police car while he's wearing a police uniform and fills a bag with a gun to take with him. As he continues into the emotional climax of laying his son's eyes for the first time, Rick realizes that thinking about good old times makes the epidemic look much worse, opting for silence for the rest of his trip. Rick gets to Atlanta and enters the city. As he advances into the city, the zombies begin to gather and her flock, knocking him off his horse. When he sees his horse being eaten by zombies, he starts shooting and shooting approaching zombies, and what's wrong with you? he screams. He enters an alley where he meets a supplies smuggler named Glenn. Glenn tells Rick to stop using his gun because it attracts the entire city's zombie population. Jim, the only survivor of Atlanta, tells them where a gun shop is five blocks from where Rick and Glenn first met. Glenn doesn't approve of the idea, and he notes that the concentration of zombies coming all the way to the city is too high for anyone to pass. Rick's taking Glenn to the zombie he killed with Shane the day before to find a solution. Rick explains the theory that zombies don't attack each other because of the smell of their rotting corpses. His plan is to rub parts of the zombie body into his clothes to smell like zombies, to make it appear that they are also undead to the zombie population. The plan works, and they can go deep into the city to get the firearms. Unfortunately, as you leave town, the rain begins, washing off the smell of zombies. This causes an attack by zombies, forcing Rick and Glenn to sprint through the hors d'am surrounding them while killing any zombies they get in their way. As Rick fend off zombies in the city, one of them bites Rick on the shoulder. Safely outside Atlanta, Rick checks his shoulder and realizes the zombie didn't bite his leather jacket. On his way back to camp with guns, Rick tells Glenn not to tell Lori about the zombie attack. Meanwhile, Shane and Lori discuss Rick's trip to the city. While Lori is concerned about Rick's well-being, Shane wants Lori to get over the rain and offer to keep his friendship. Lori scolds him for saying he needs to cut ties now that Rick's back. Dale's wife died in the first outbreak as she left Florida. After burying him, Dale came to Atlanta to find his cousins. He ran into Amy and Andrea. Andrea was taking Amy back to college. Andrea had a job as a clerk at a law firm, and Amy was studying physical education in college. Glenn was a pizza delivery man floating in debt, and when the dead began to rise, he almost had to ask his parents for money. He's deeply remorseful because he knows he can't talk to them even if he wants to. Allen ran a shoe store in a mall and was also struggling to get his two sides together. Jim says you're just a mechanic. Finally, Carol tells how her husband, a successful car salesman, committed suicide when he saw his parents being eaten by zombies. She also implied that she was abusive and persuaded her to stay with him long enough to just look after Sophia. When Amy sees a zombie, she goes to the trailer to use the toilet, causing her to unknowingly return to another zombie who bites her in the neck and kills her. The zombies appeared to be just a few of the larger herd that surrounded the camp, asking survivors for a violent panic. Rescued by Carol and Sophia Glenn, Andrea mourns Amy's body, unaware of everything. Lori is almost killed by a zombie, but Carl is saved by the zombie shoot. Jim sings in anger and attacks a zombie and repeatedly yells that he killed his family. When all the zombies die, Andrea shoots Amy in the head to keep her from reviving. It was later revealed that Jim had been bitten on the arm when he killed the zombie. The next day, a funeral is held for Amy. Shane, Donna, Dale and Rick take turns praising him. Jim has perhaps the biggest speech, saying that no one deserves this kind of death, especially a nice one Like Amy. Andrea's depressed, and Jim's getting really sick. Meanwhile, Rick, Shane and Carl go hunting. Carl reminds Rick that they don't need so much food because Amy's dead and Jim's too sick to eat, and he provokes Shane to yell at Rick, and tells him it's not his fault. When they get back, Donna informs them of Jim's desire to leave her out of Atlanta. Jim hopes that when he turns, he can be reunited with the zombieized members of his family. The band brought him out of Atlanta and said goodbye. The next day, Shane tells Rick to prepare for the hunt. Rick tells Carl to stay behind so he can talk to Shane, and he tells Shane to start yelling again to Rick that Jim and Amy are dead and that it's not their fault they punched him. Lori then punches Shane, yelling what fuck is wrong about you?!, shane mentally snap and cause you to run away. Rick follows Shane and Carl, takes turns following his father. Rick starts yelling at Shane how he lost everyone's respect for Rick when he caught up with Shane, and how Lori would have changed over time and loved him if Rick hadn't come back. Shane then pointed his gun at the bewildered, defenseless Rick and said he should never return. However, before shooting him, Carl shoots Shane in the neck, causing Shane to drown in his own blood until he is dead. It's not the same as Rick and Carl killing the dead. It should never be.
